

- The INL-3ANPT30 is a high speed and high sensitive silicon NPN phototransistor in a standard 3mm epoxy package.
- Due to its black epoxy, the device is matched to visible light and infrared radiation.






Typical Characteristic Curves


Spectral Sensitivity




Collector Current & Irradiance




Relative Collector Current & Ambient Temperature




Collector Power Dissipation & Ambient Temperature








