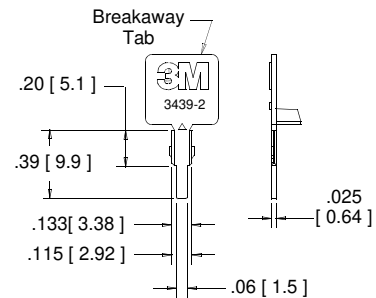
Connector Body

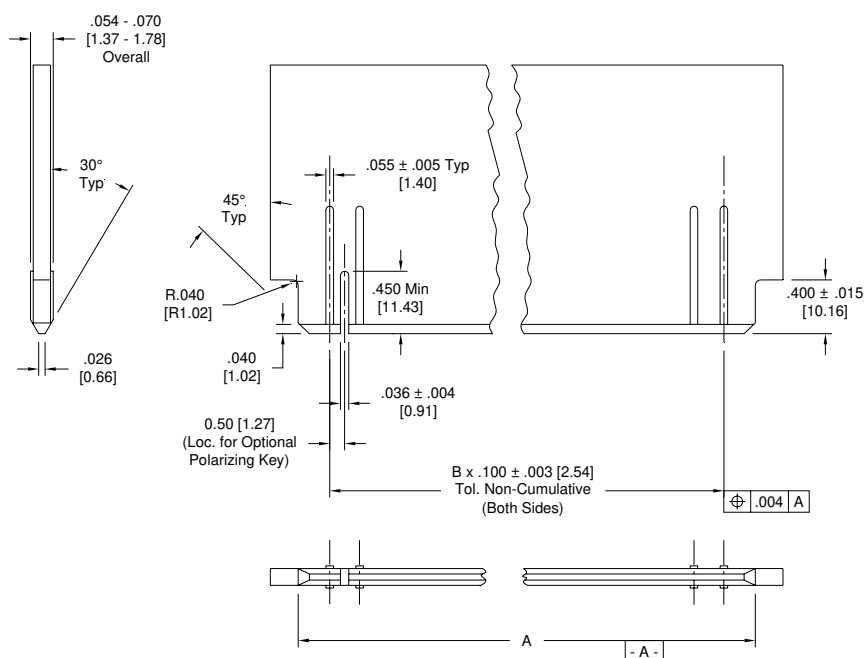
