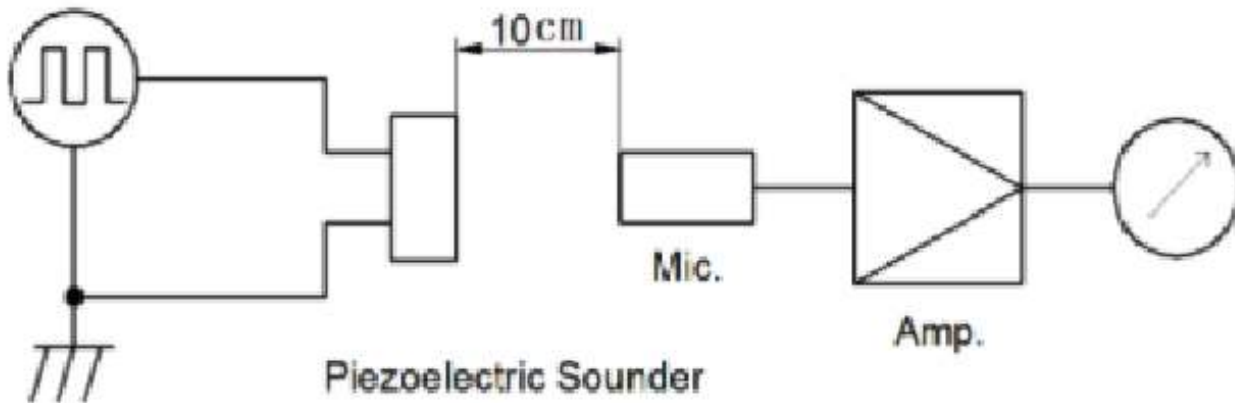

- 110mm long lead wires and mounting flange for easy integration

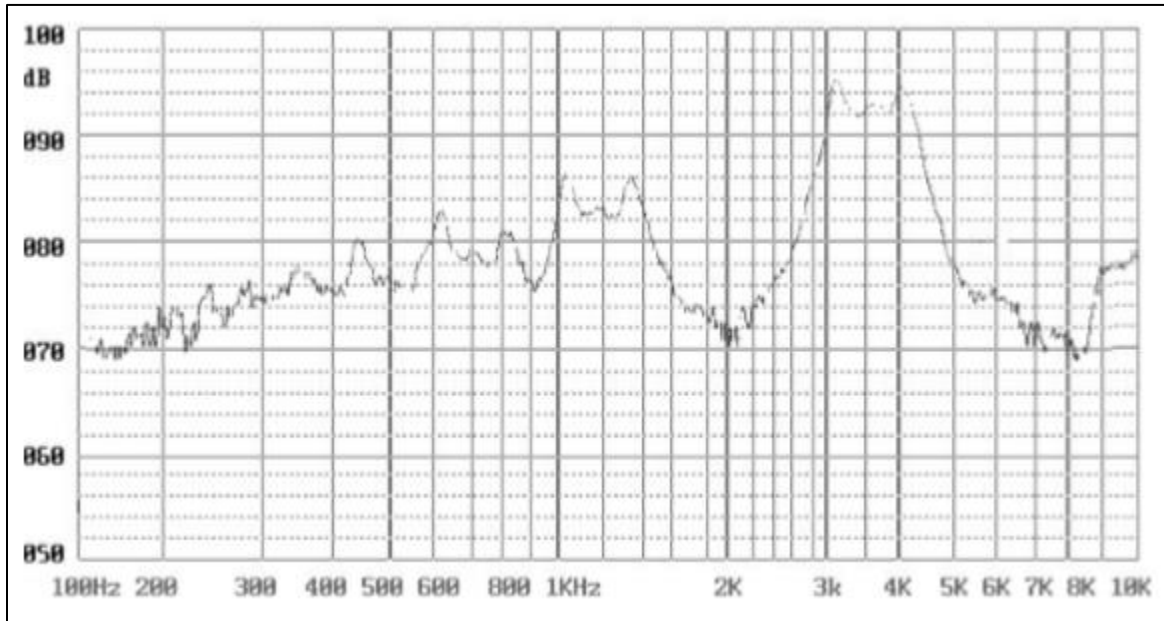

Typical Frequency Response (9 Vp-p sine-sweep with microphone spaced at 10cm)

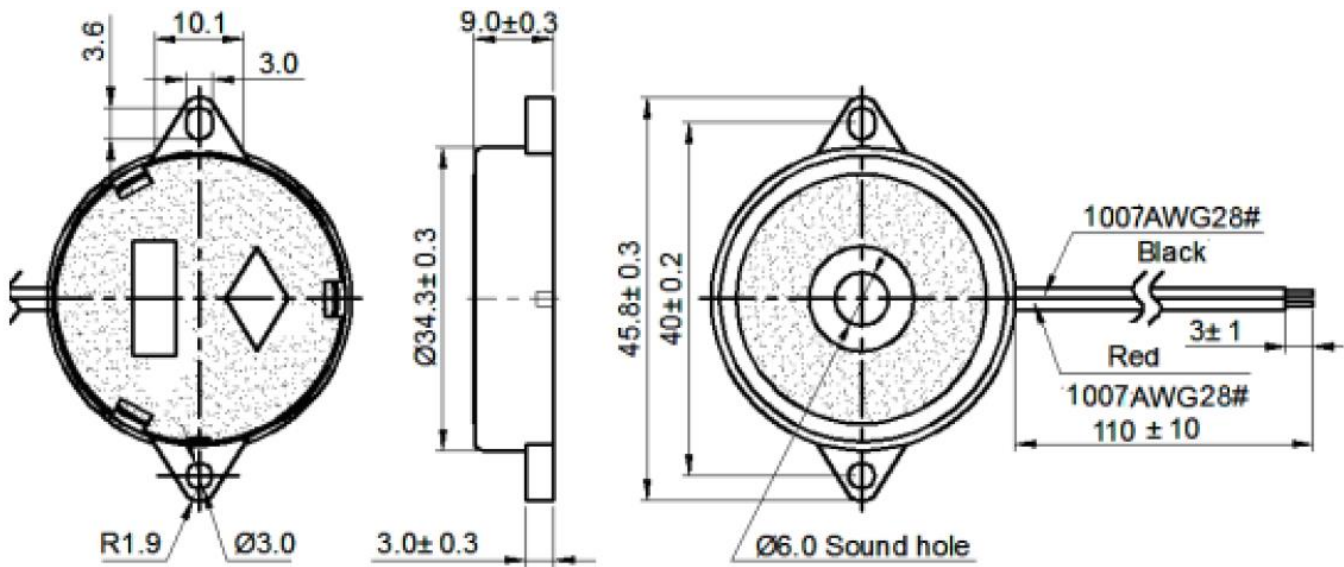


Reliability Testing

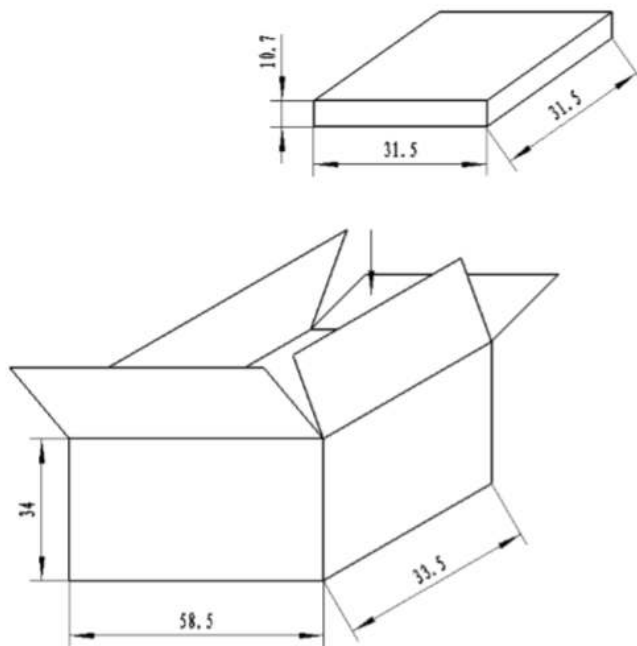
Type of Test	Test Specifications
High Temperature Test	+85±2°C, 96HRS
Low Temperature Test	-30±2°C, 96HRS
Humidity Test	40±2°C, 93 (+2/-3) %RH, 96HRS
Temperature Cycle Testing	-30±2°C, 30 minutes room temp. 15 minutes +85±2°C, 30 minutes room temp. 15 minutes 5 cycles
Vibration Test	Test directions of X, Y, and Z (a total of 0.5 hour). Sweep time (from 10 to 55 Hz and then from 55 to 10 Hz) under an amplitude of 1.0 mm for 1 minute.
Drop Test	Drop 3 times from height of 70cm onto the surface of 10mm thick wooden board.

After being placed for 2 to 4hrs at room temp, the product shall meet specifications, except the SPL should be in ± 10dB compared with initial one
