







Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient



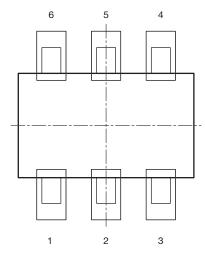
PAD Pattern

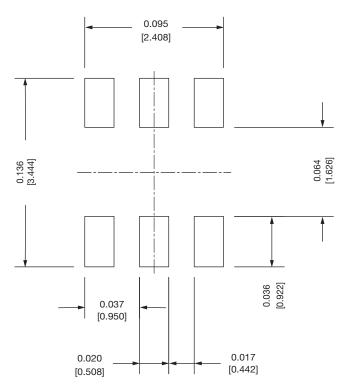
Recommended Land Pattern For TSOP-5L / TSOP-6L
