




Figure 1. Lead Temperature Measurement Conditions




Figure 2. $I_{F(AV)}$ vs. $T_L(T_J = 150 \, ^{\circ}\text{C}, V_R = 0 \, \text{V})$




Figure 3. $I_{F(AV)}$ vs. $T_L(T_J = 150 \, ^{\circ}\text{C}, \, V_R = 40 \, \text{V})$




Figure 4. $P_{F(MAX)}$ vs. $I_{F(AV)}$ ($T_J = 150$ °C)




Figure 6. Typical Characteristics: I_F vs. V_F




Figure 5. $P_{R(MAX)}$ vs. V_R ($T_J = 150$ °C)




Figure 7. Typical Characteristics: I_R vs. V_R







Figure 8. Typical Transient Thermal Resistance Characteristics

- Flow: 260 °C / 10 s, 1 time


Reflow:

Preheat: 150 °C to 200 °C / 60 s to 120 s

Solder heating: 255 °C / 30s, 3 times (260 °C peak)

- Soldering Iron: $350 \, ^{\circ}\text{C} / 3.5 \, \text{s}, \, 1 \, \text{time}$


