## 1.1 General description

Logic level N-channel enhancement mode Field-Effect Transistor (FET) in a plastic package using TrenchMOS technology. This product has been designed and qualified to the appropriate AEC standard for use in automotive critical applications.






Fig 1. Normalized continuous drain current as a function of mounting base temperature




Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration




Fig 5. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values






Fig 7. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage

Fig 8. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values




Fig 9. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values





Fig 11. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature

Fig 10. Gate-source voltage as a function of turn-on gate charge; typical values




Fig 12. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values




Fig 13. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature




Fig 14. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values




Fig 15. Reverse diode current as a function of reverse diode voltage; typical values




Fig 16. Package outline SOT404 (D2PAK)
