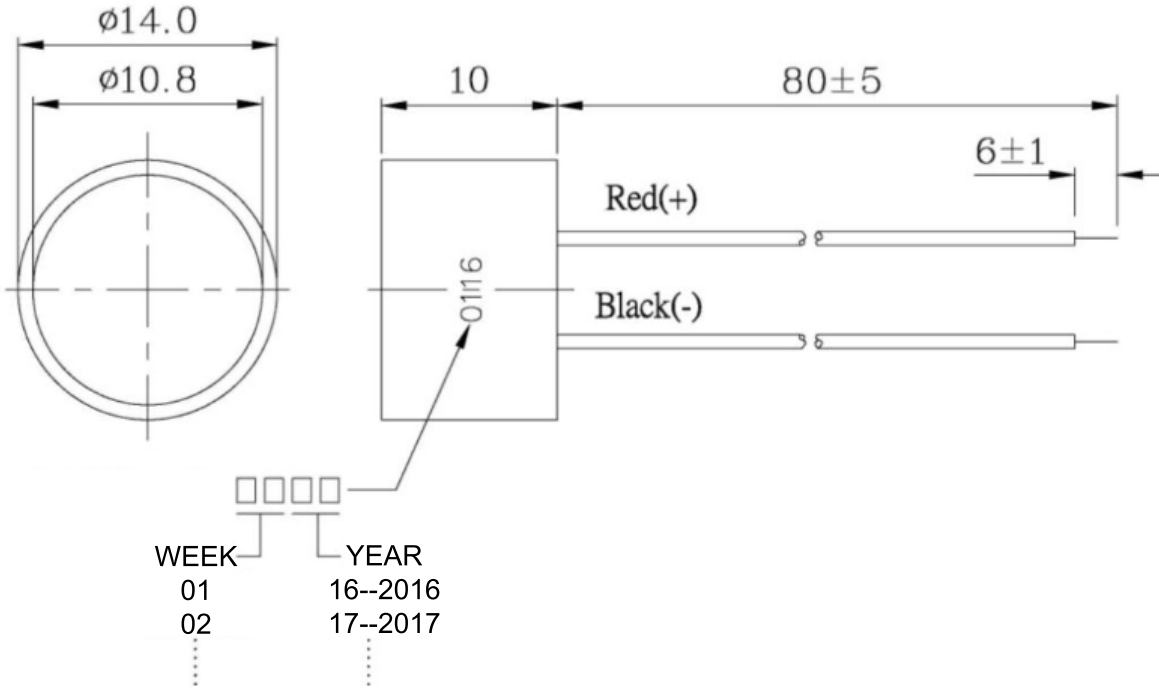

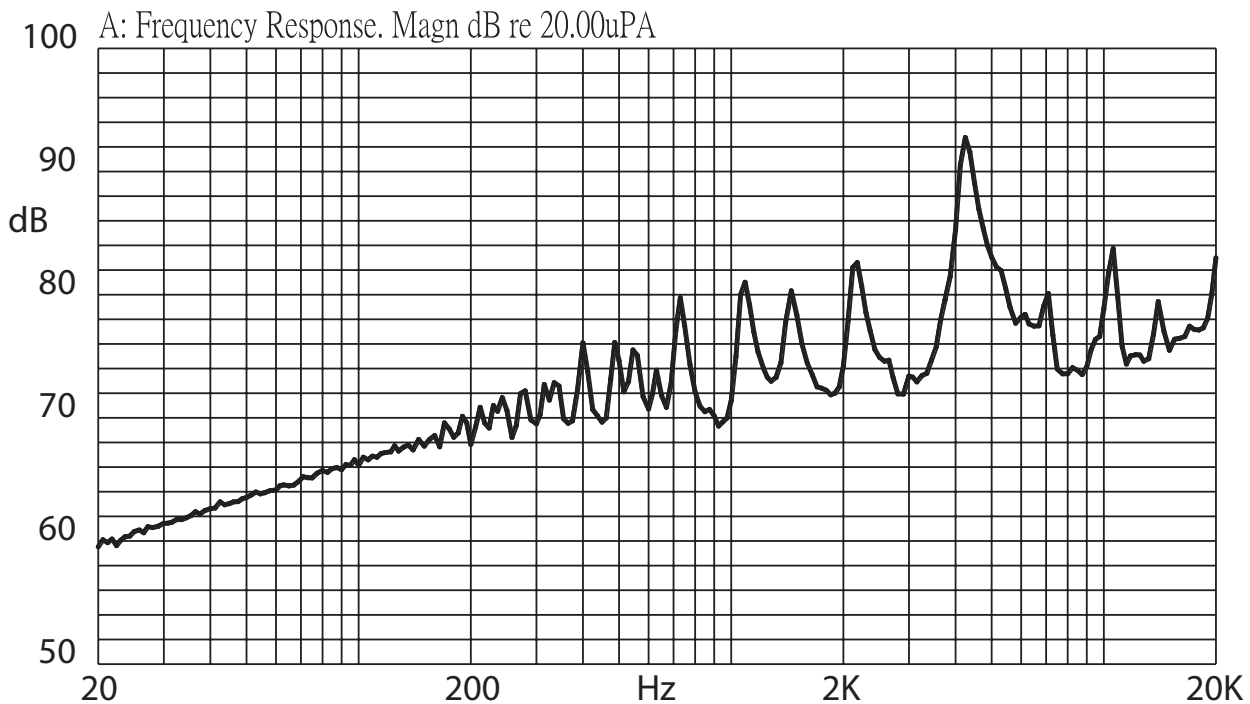

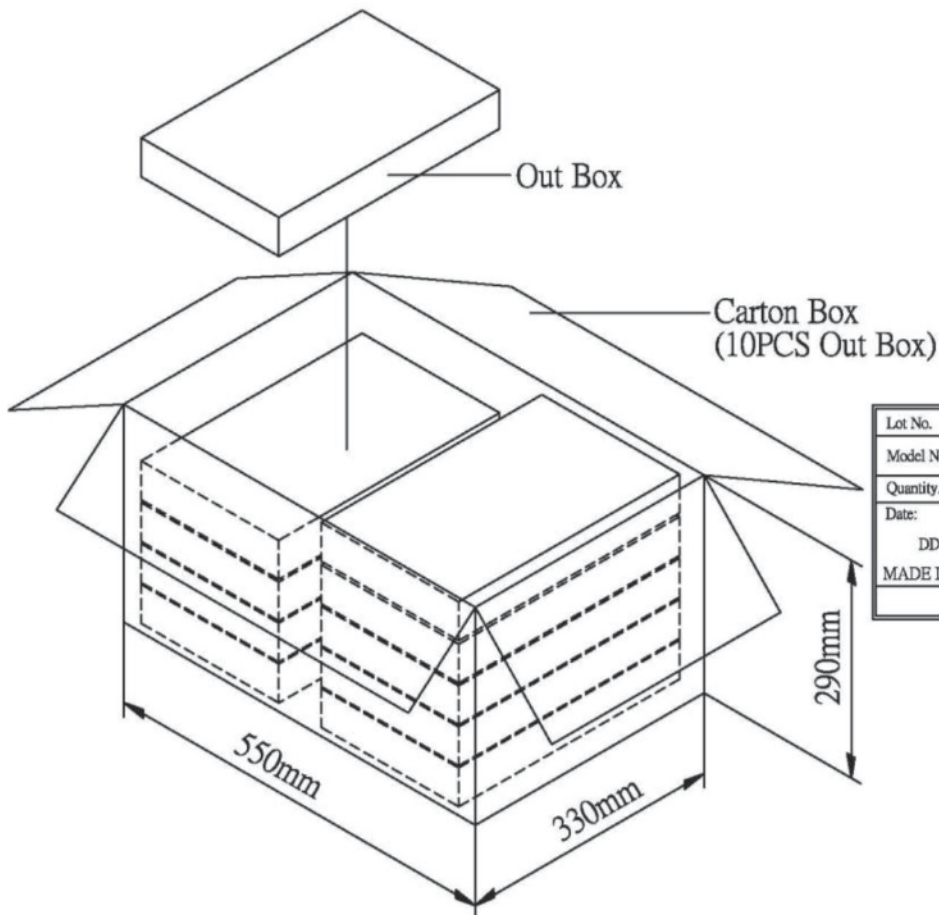
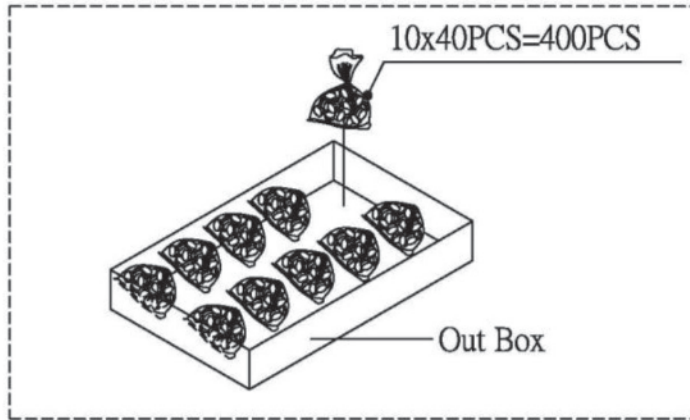
FREQUENCY RESPONSE CURVE
