
#### **General Description**

This package integrates two N-Channel devices connected internally in common-source configuration. This enables very low package parasitics and optimized thermal path to the common source pad on the bottom. It provides a very small footprint  $(3.3 \times 5 \text{ mm})$  for higher power density.








Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics




Figure 3. Normalized On Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




Figure 5. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 2. Normalized On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 4. On Resistance vs. Gate to Source Voltage




Figure 6. Source to Drain Diode Forward Voltage vs. Source Current




Figure 7. Gate Charge Characteristics




Figure 9. Unclamped Inductive Switching Capability




Figure 11. Forward Bias Safe Operating Area




Figure 8. Capacitance vs. Drain to Source Voltage




Figure 10. Maximum Continuous Drain Current vs. Case Temperature




Figure 12. Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation








Figure 13. Junction-to-Case Transient Thermal Response Curve





