




Fig.1 Power Dissipation vs. Case Temperature

Fig.2 Collector Current vs. Case Temperature




#### Fig.3 Forward Bias Safe Operating Area

Fig.8 Typical Collector To Emitter Saturation Voltage




Fig.6 Typical Output Characteristics





Fig.9 Typical Collector To Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Gate To Emitter Voltage







Fig.16 Typical Gate Charge






