




Fig. 4 - Maximum Thermal Impedance Z_{thJC} Characteristics (Per Leg)




VS-20CTQ...PbF Series, VS-20CTQ...-N3 Series

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


Fig. 7 - Maximum Non-Repetitive Surge Current (Per Leg)




Fig. 8 - Unclamped Inductive Test Circuit

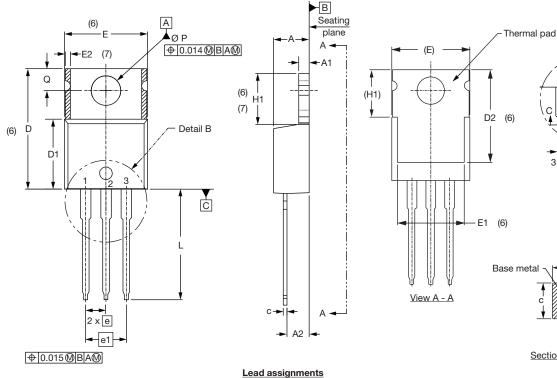
