



Fig.1 Input Voltage vs. Output Current (ON Characteristics)






Fig.2 Output Current vs. Input Voltage (OFF Characteristics)




Fig.3 Output Current vs. Output Voltage

OUTPUT CURRENT : Io [mA]





Fig.4 DC Current Gain vs. Output Current





Fig.5 Output Voltage vs. Output Current


