The SJPL-L4 is a fast recovery diode of 400 V / 3.0 A. The maximum t_{rr} of 50 ns is realized by optimizing a life-time control.






Figure 1. Lead Temperature Measurement Conditions




Figure 2. $I_{F(AV)}$ vs. $T_L (T_J = 150 \text{ °C}, V_R = 0 \text{ V})$




Figure 3. $I_{F(AV)}$ vs. T_L (T_J = 150 °C, V_R = 400 V)




Figure 4. $P_{F(MAX)}$ vs. $I_{F(AV)}$ (T_J = 150 °C)




Figure 6. Typical Characteristics: I_F vs. V_F




Figure 5. $P_{R(MAX)}$ vs. V_R ($T_J = 150 \ ^{\circ}C$)




Figure 7. Typical Characteristics: I_R vs. V_R






Figure 8. Typical Transient Thermal Resistance Characteristics




• SJP Land Pattern Example
