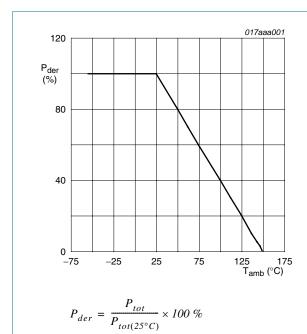
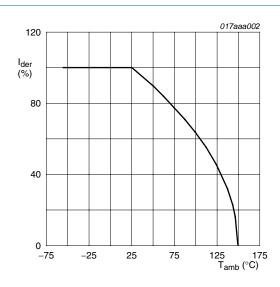


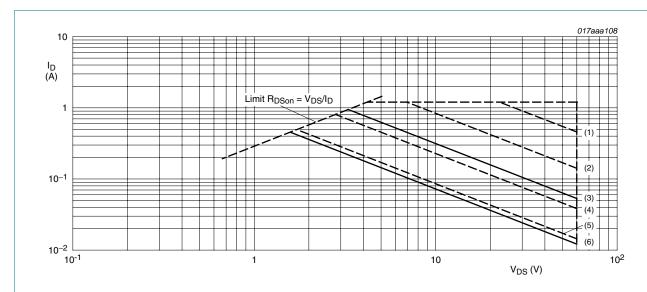
Fig 1. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of ambient temperature

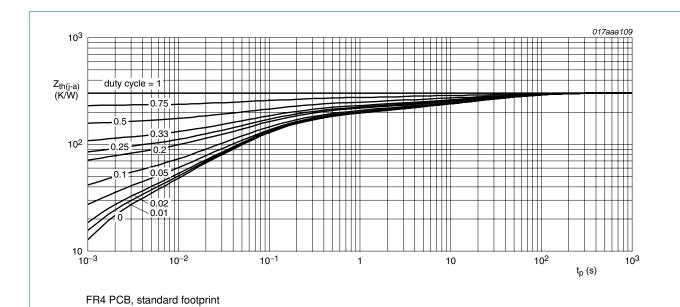


Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

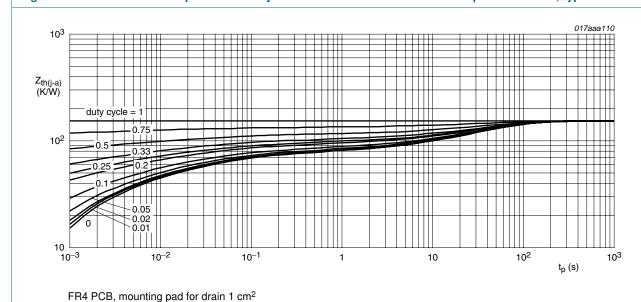


Fig 5. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

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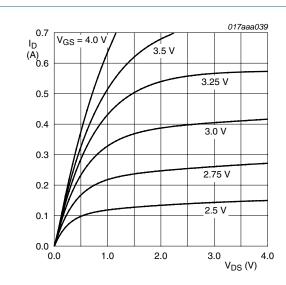

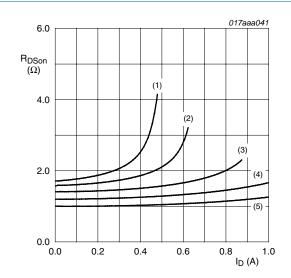

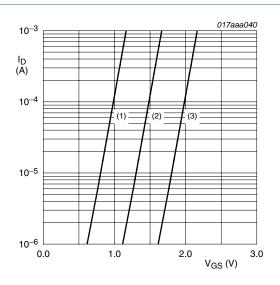

Fig 8. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values



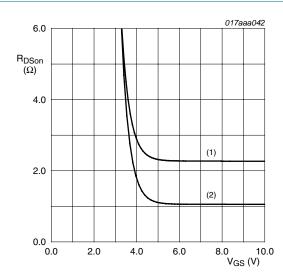

Fig 7. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage



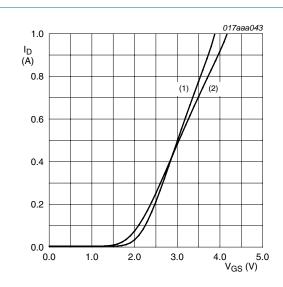

Fig 9. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

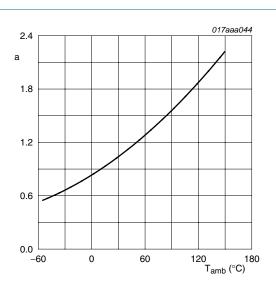

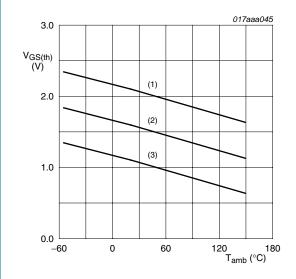

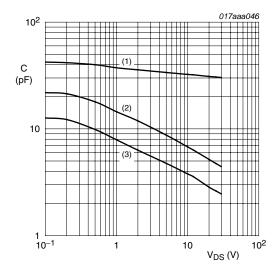
Fig 11. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance as a function of ambient temperature; typical values

Fig 13. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values

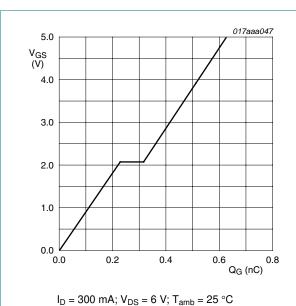


Fig 14. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values

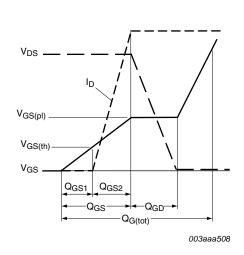
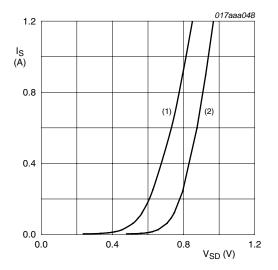


Fig 15. Gate charge waveform definitions

Fig 16. Source current as a function of source-drain voltage; typical values

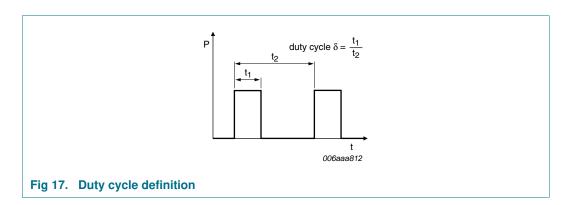

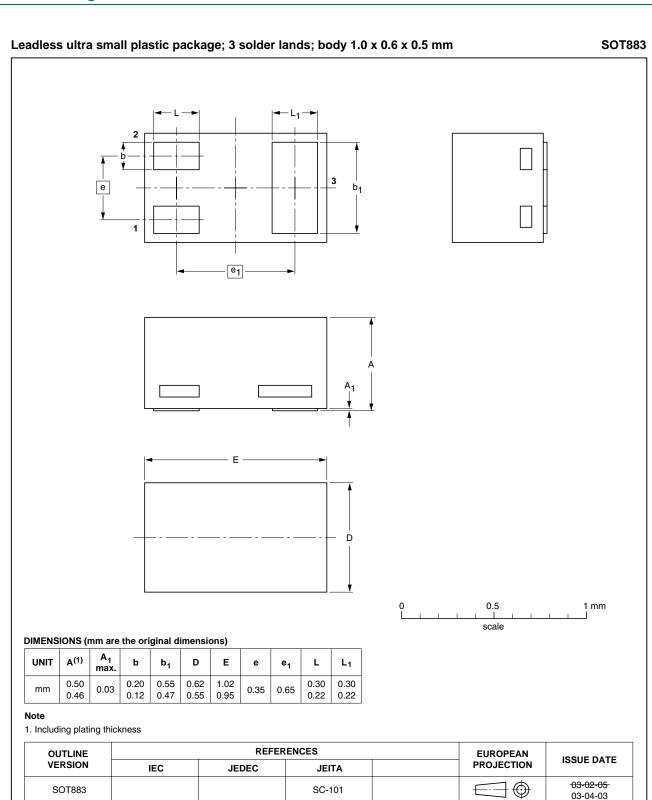


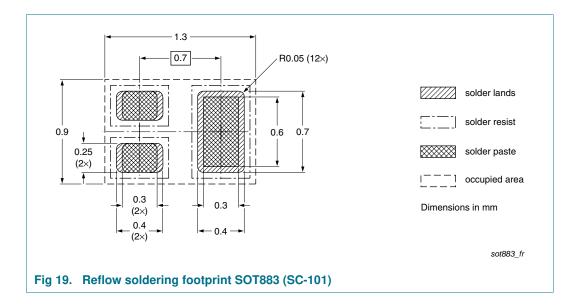
Fig 18. Package outline SOT883 (SC-101)
