## Description


The TS914 device is a rail-to-rail CMOS quad operational amplifier designed to operate with a single or dual supply voltage.

The input voltage range  $V_{icm}$  includes the two supply rails  $V_{CC+}$  and  $V_{CC-}.$ 

The output reaches V<sub>CC-</sub> +50 mV, V<sub>CC+</sub> -50 mV, with R<sub>L</sub> = 10 kΩ, and V<sub>CC-</sub> +350 mV, V<sub>CC+</sub> - 350 mV, with R<sub>L</sub> = 600 Ω

This product offers a broad supply voltage operating range from 2.7 to 16 V and a supply current of only 200  $\mu$ A/amp. (V<sub>CC</sub> = 3 V).

The source and sink output current capability is typically 40 mA (at  $V_{CC}$  = 3 V), fixed by an internal limitation circuit.

1. All voltage values, except differential voltage are with respect to network ground terminal.

2. Differential voltages are the non-inverting input terminal with respect to the inverting input terminal.

- 3. The magnitude of input and output voltages must never exceed  $V_{CC}^+$  +0.3 V.
- 4. Short-circuits can cause excessive heating. Destructive dissipation can result from simultaneous shortcircuit on all amplifiers. These are typical values.
- 5. Human body model: a 100 pF capacitor is charged to the specified voltage, then discharged through a 1.5 k $\Omega$  resistor between two pins of the device. This is done for all couples of connected pin combinations while the other pins are floating.
- 6. Machine model: a 200 pF capacitor is charged to the specified voltage, then discharged directly between two pins of the device with no external series resistor (internal resistor < 5  $\Omega$ ). This is done for all couples of connected pin combinations while the other pins are floating.
- 7. Charged device model: all pins and the package are charged together to the specified voltage and then discharged directly to ground through only one pin. This is done for all pins.








Figure 4. Low level output voltage vs. low level Figure 5. Input bias current vs. temperature output current ( $V_{CC}$  = +5 V,  $V_{CC}$  = +3 V)







Figure 6. High level output voltage vs. high level output current  $(V_{CC} = +16 V, V_{CC} = +10 V)$ 



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



Figure 10. Phase margin vs. supply voltage (RL = 10 k $\Omega$ )








Figure 12. Gain bandwidth product vs. supply Figure 13. Phase margin vs. supply voltage voltage ( $R_L = 600 \Omega$ ) ( $R_L = 600 \Omega$ )











## 4 Macromodels

#### 4.1 Important note concerning this macromodel

- All models are a trade-off between accuracy and complexity (that is, simulation time). Macromodels are not a substitute for breadboarding; rather, they confirm the validity of a design approach and help to select surrounding component values.
- A macromodel emulates the nominal performance of a typical device within specified operating conditions (such as temperature or supply voltage, etc.). Thus, the macromodel is often not as exhaustive as the datasheet, its purpose is to illustrate the main parameters of the product.
- Data derived from macromodels used outside of the specified conditions (such as V<sub>CC</sub>, or temperature) or even worse, outside of the device's operating conditions (such as V<sub>CC</sub> or V<sub>icm</sub>) is not reliable in any way.

The values provided in *Table 6* are derived from this macromodel.

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
