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




Fig.3 DC current gain as a function of collector





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In Figs 7 to 9, G_{UM} = maximum unilateral power gain; MSG = maximum stable gain; G_{max} = maximum available gain.







Fig.6 Gain as a function of collector current.







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




Fig.10 Minimum noise figure as a function of collector current.





