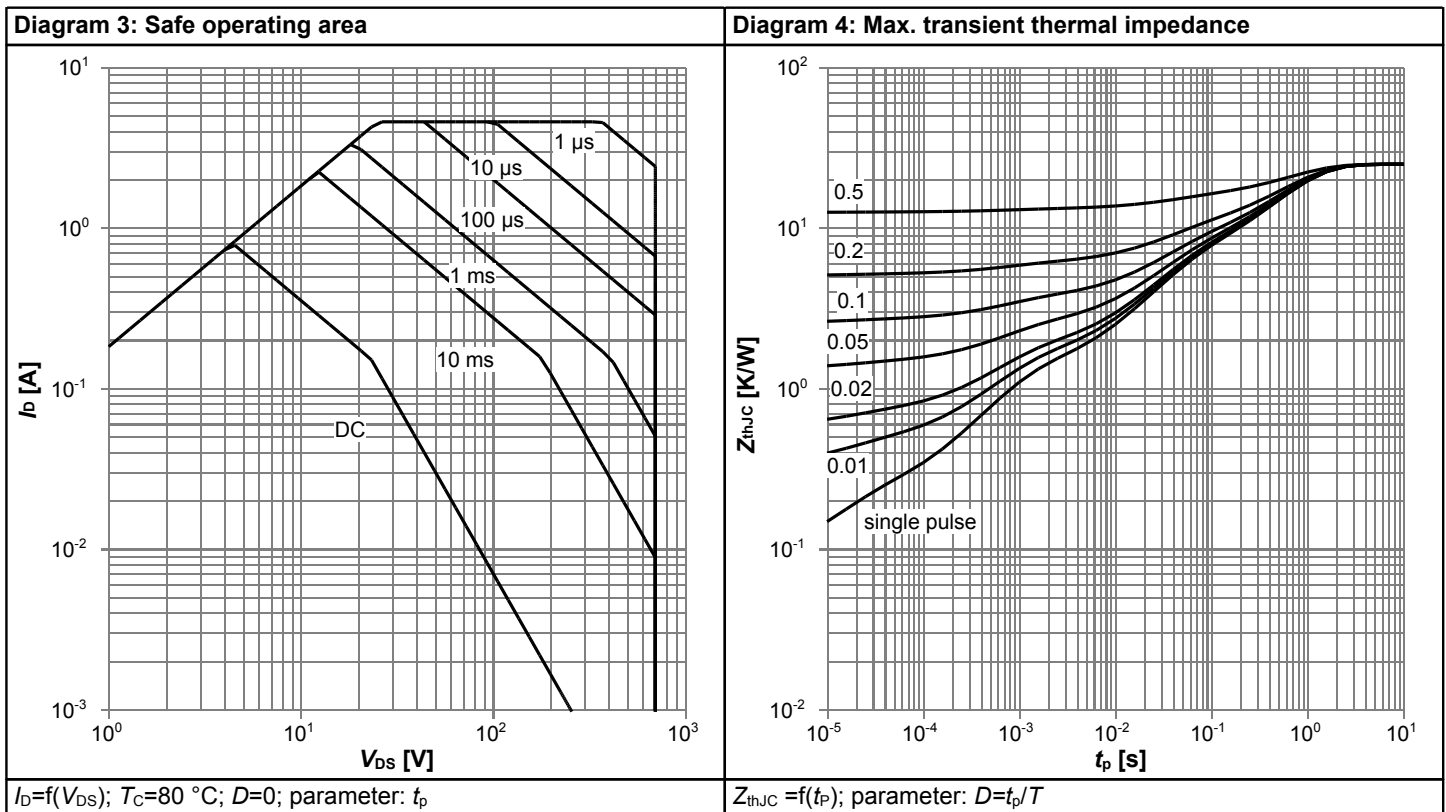
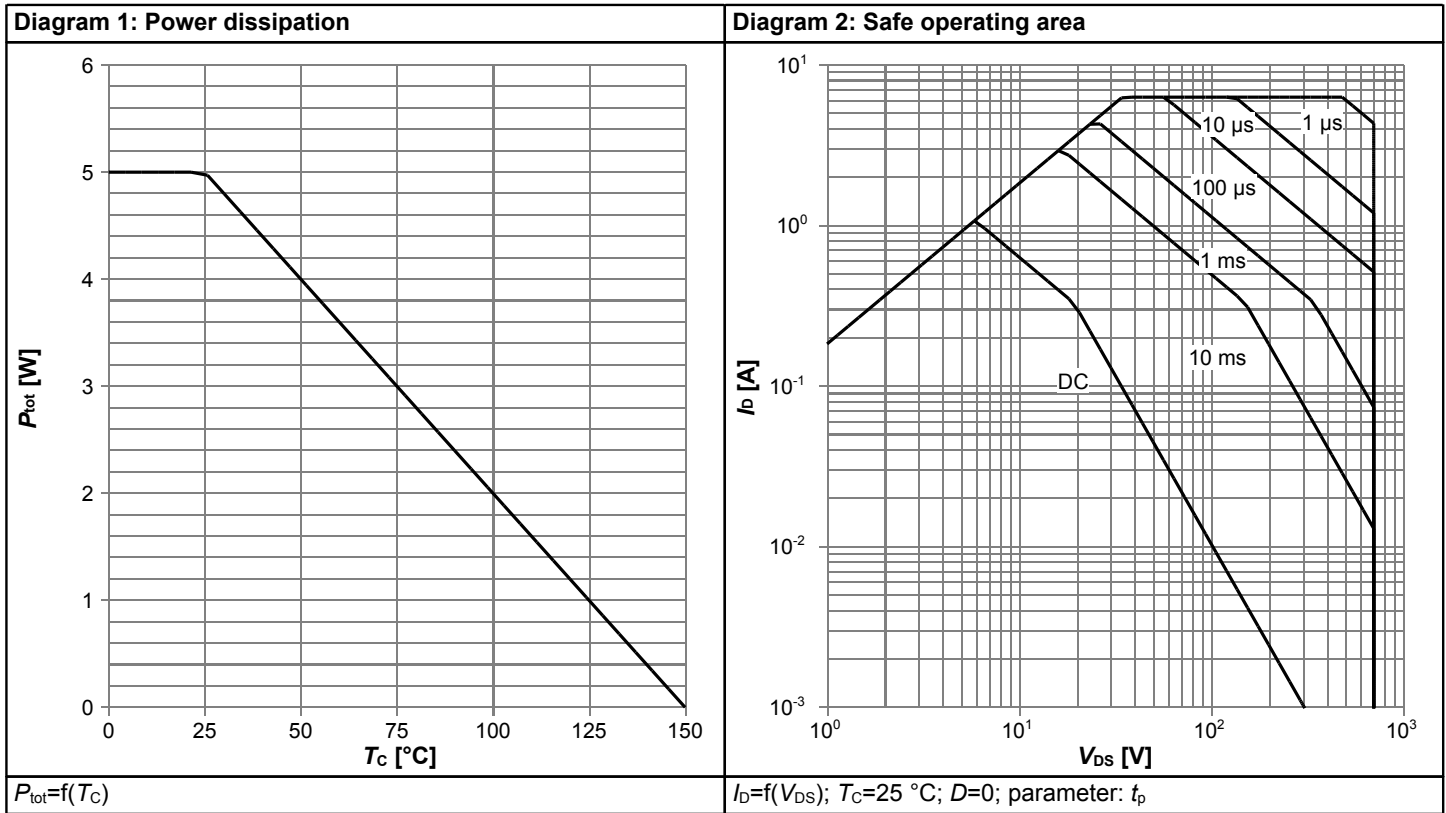

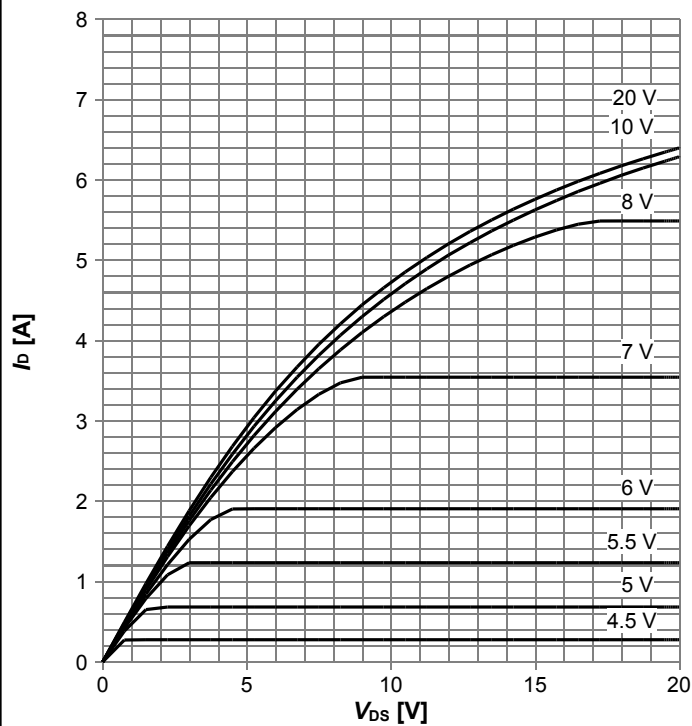

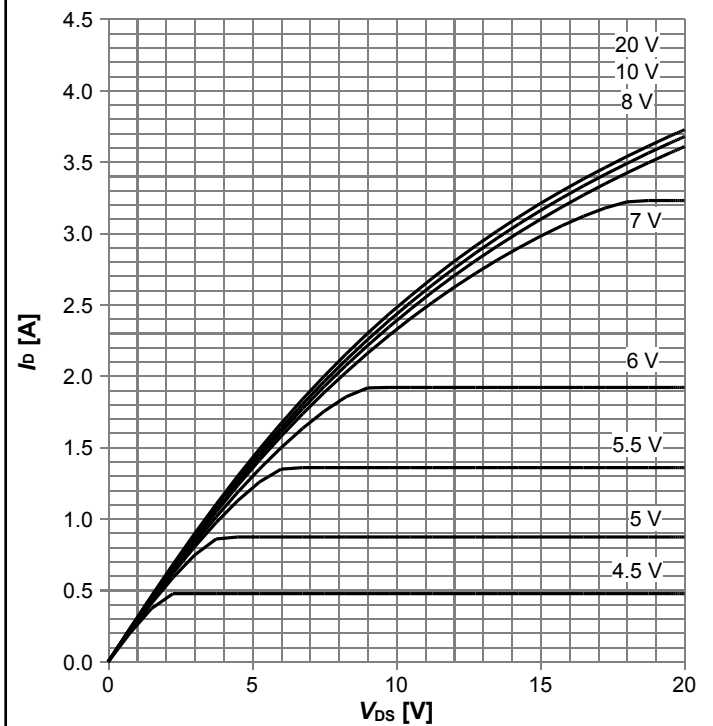

Diagram 5: Typ. output characteristics



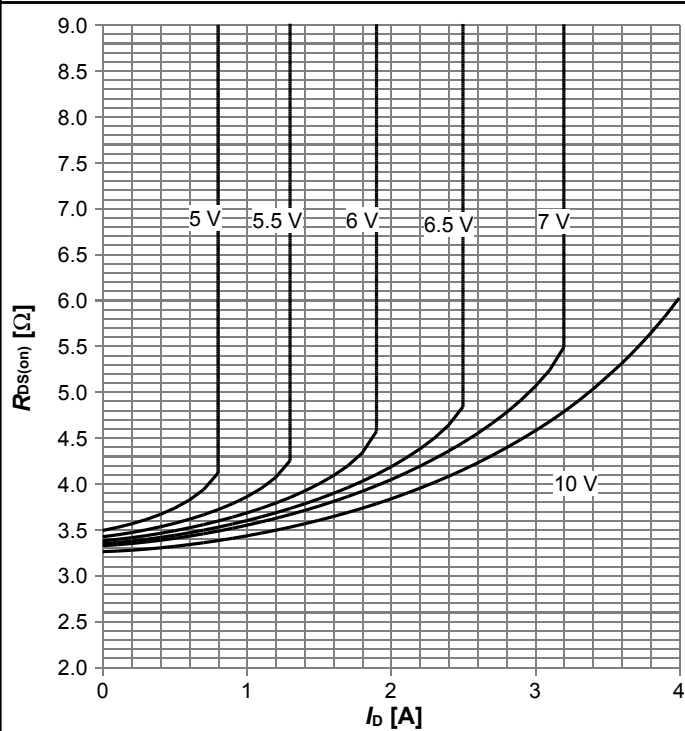

Diagram 6: Typ. output characteristics



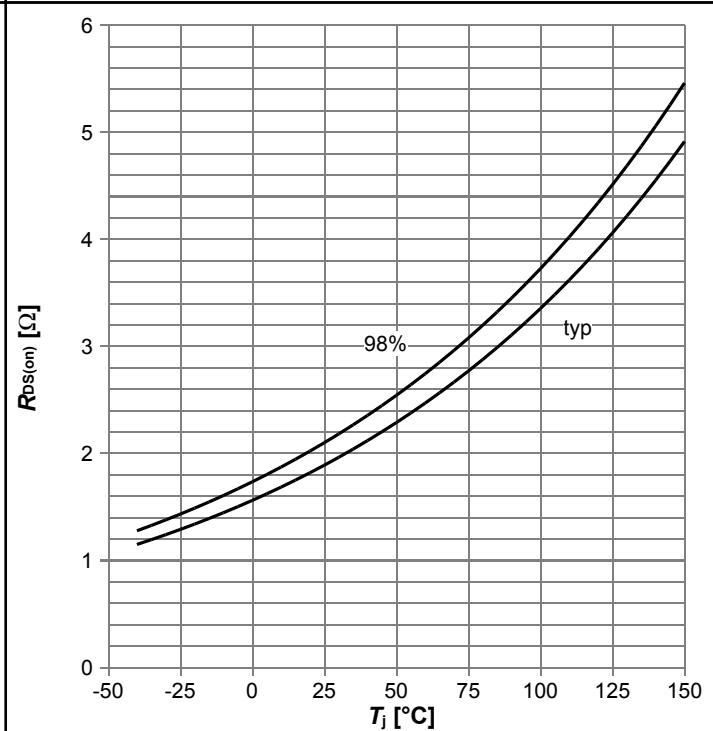
$I_D=f(V_{DS})$; $T_j=125\text{ }^\circ\text{C}$; parameter: V_{GS}

Diagram 7: Typ. drain-source on-state resistance



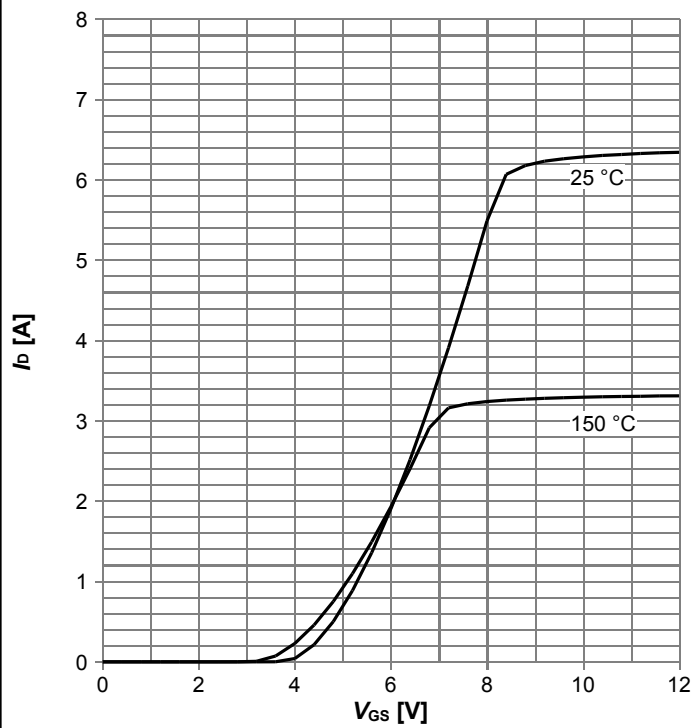
$R_{DS(on)}=f(I_D)$; $T_j=125\text{ }^\circ\text{C}$; parameter: V_{GS}

Diagram 8: Drain-source on-state resistance



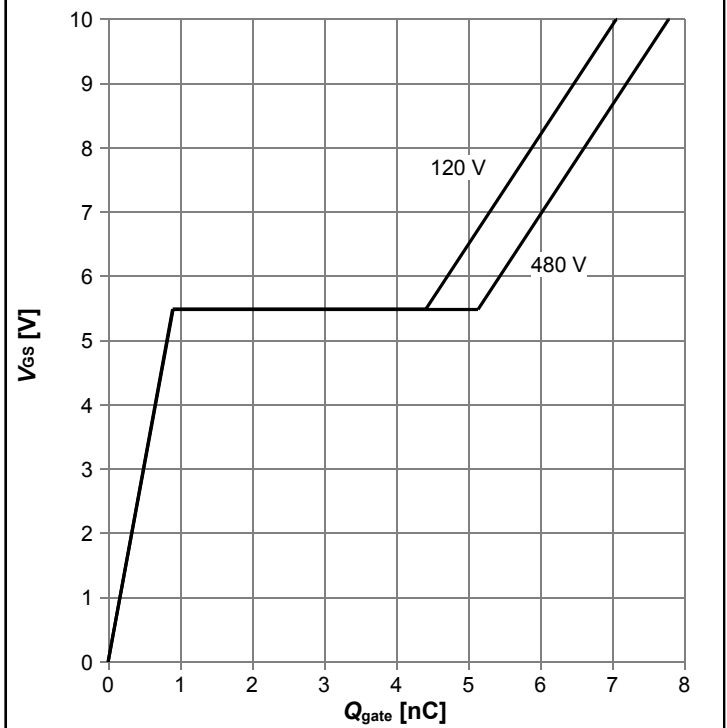

Diagram 9: Typ. transfer characteristics



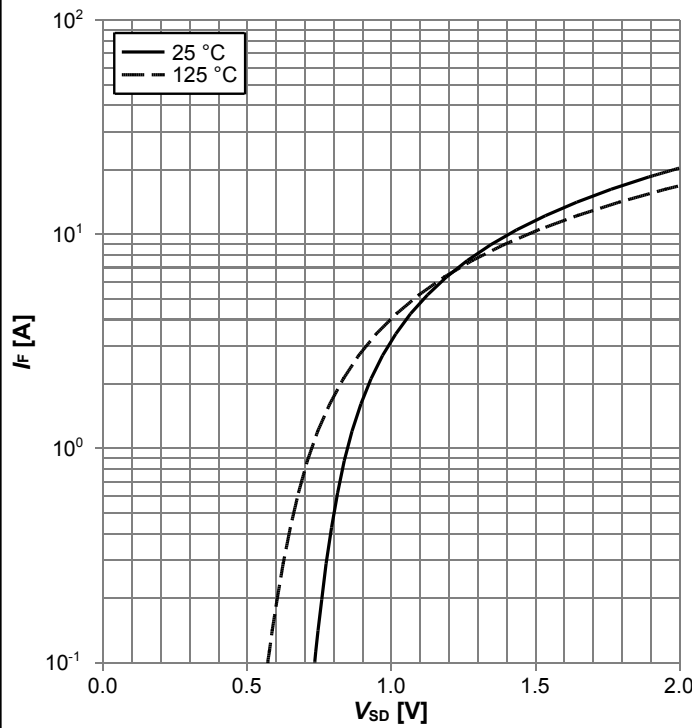
$I_D = f(V_{GS})$; $V_{DS} = 20V$; parameter: T_j

Diagram 10: Typ. gate charge



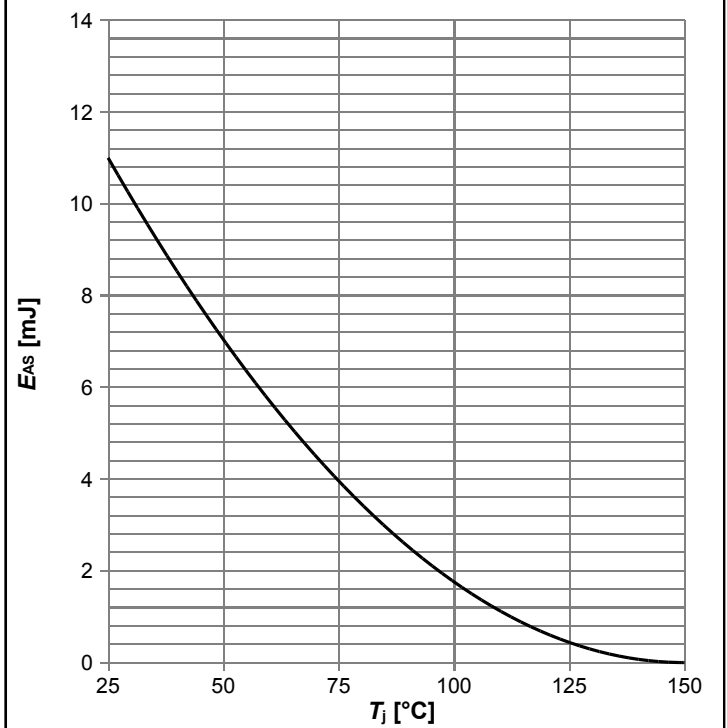
$V_{GS} = f(Q_{gate})$; $I_D = 1.1 A$ pulsed; parameter: V_{DD}

Diagram 12: Avalanche energy

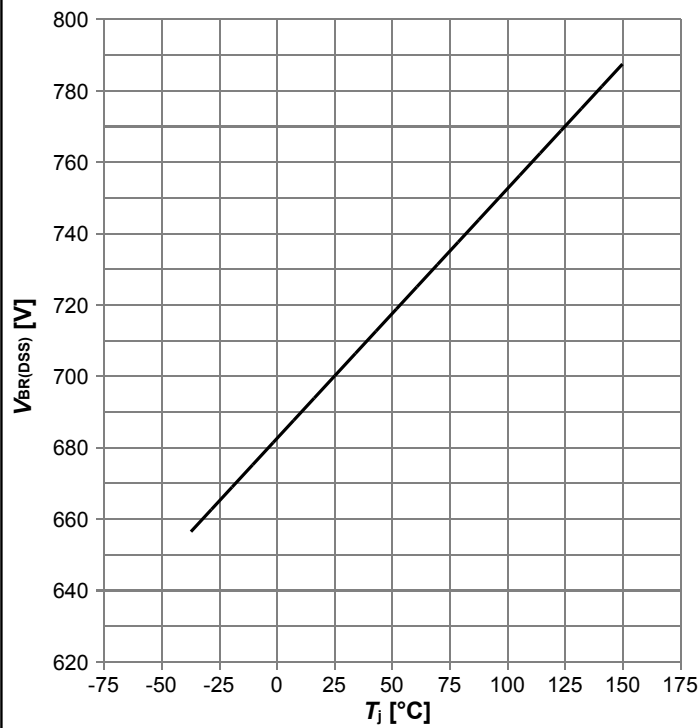


$E_{AS} = f(T_j)$; $I_D = 0.4 A$; $V_{DD} = 50 V$

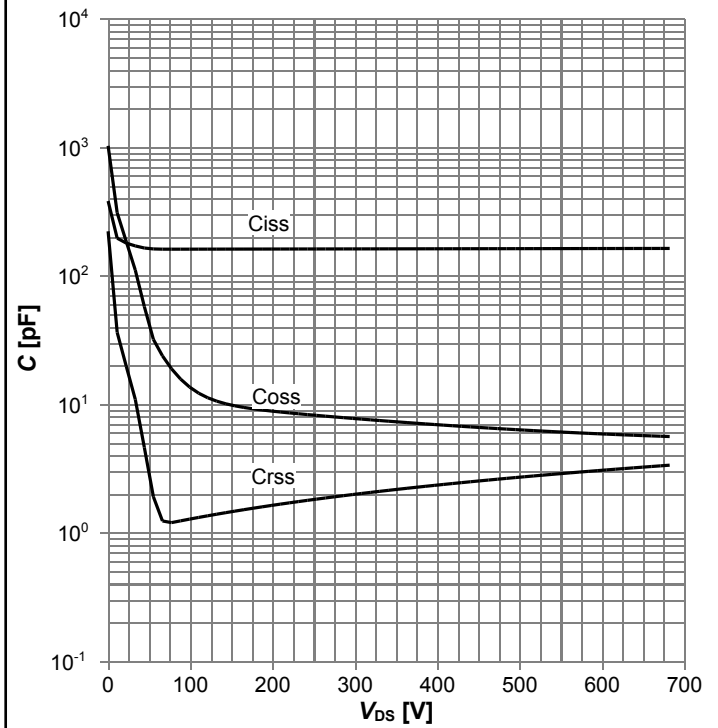

Diagram 13: Drain-source breakdown voltage



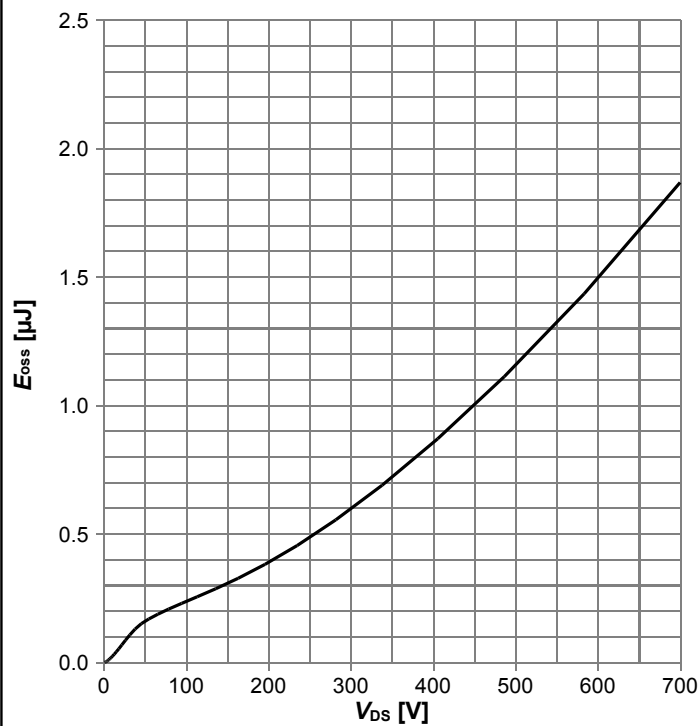


