Description




Figure 1. MicroPak™ (Top Through View)





Logic Configurations






Figure 6. 2-Input NOR Gate




Figure 8. Inverter



Figure 9. **AC Test Circuit**




Figure 10. **AC Waveforms**




Figure 11. 6-Lead, MicroPak™, 1.0 mm Wide




Figure 12. 6-Lead, MicroPak2™, 1x1 mm Body, .35 mm Pitch
