
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
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TRIACS 10 AMPERES RMS 600 thru 800 VOLTS








Quadrant Definitions for a Triac





Figure 2. Power Dissipation








Figure 4. Maximum Non-Repetitive Surge Current





Figure 5. Typical Gate Trigger Voltage






Figure 6. Typical Gate Trigger Current

Figure 7. Typical Holding Current






Figure 8. Thermal Response
