



Figure 1. Logic Symbol




Figure 2. SOT23-5, SC-88A and SC-74A (Top View)




Figure 4. AC Test Circuit





Figure 5. AC Waveforms

Figure 6. I_{CCD} Test Circuit

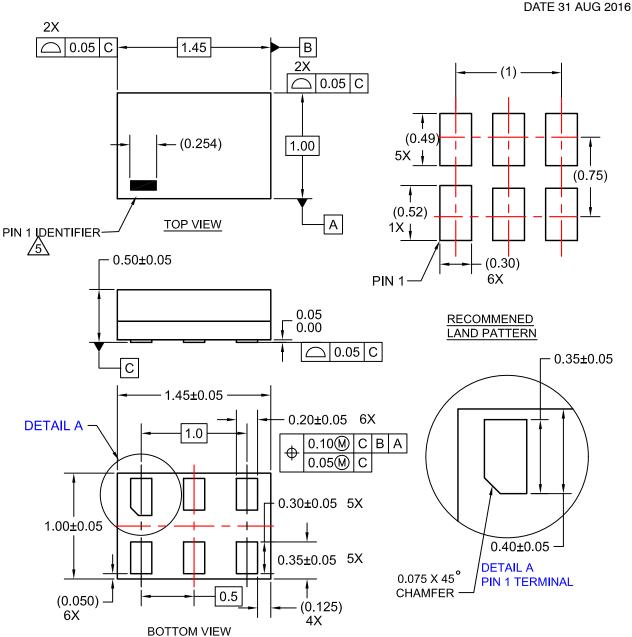
