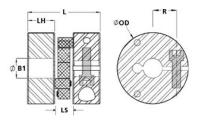

Ruland MCPTS37-14-A, Controlflex Coupling Hub, Aluminum, Clamp Style, 37.0mm OD, 24.0mm Length





Description

Ruland MCPTS37-14-A is a Controlflex coupling hub with a 14mm bore, 37.0mm OD, and 24.0mm length. It is a component in a three-piece design consisting of two aluminum hubs mounted by pins to one acetal insert creating a lightweight low inertia coupling capable of speeds up to 22,000 RPM. This three-piece design allows for a highly customizable coupling that easily combines clamp hubs with inch, metric, keyed, and keyless bores. MCPTS37-14-A has a thinner length than regular hubs allowing it to be used in confined spaces. Hardware is metric and tests beyond DIN 912 12.9 standards for maximum torque capabilities. Controlflex couplings have a balanced design for reduced vibrations at high speeds, can accommodate all forms of misalignment, and are an excellent fit for encoders, tachometers, and light duty stepper servo positioning applications. MCPTS37-14-A is RoHS3 and REACH compliant.

- 5. Align the drive pins on the second hub to match the holes in the insert(s).
- 6. Verify that the space between hubs is 0.393 in, 10.0 mm.
- 7. Tighten the clamp screw on the second hub to the recommended seating torque of 1.3 Nm using a 2.5 mm hex torque wrench.
