Third generation Power MOSFETs from Vishay provide the designer with the best combination of fast switching, ruggedized device design, low on-resistance and cost-effectiveness.

The TO-247AC package is preferred for commercial-industrial applications where higher power levels preclude the use of TO-220AB devices. The TO-247AC is similar but superior to the earlier TO-218 package because its isolated mounting hole. It also provides greater creepage distances between pins to meet the requirements of most safety specifications.




Fig. 1 - Typical Output Characteristics, T_C = 25 °C




Fig. 2 - Typical Output Characteristics, $T_C = 150$ °C




Fig. 3 - Typical Transfer Characteristics




Fig. 4 - Normalized On-Resistance vs. Temperature




Fig. 5 - Typical Capacitance vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage




Fig. 6 - Typical Gate Charge vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Fig. 7 - Typical Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage




Fig. 8 - Maximum Safe Operating Area

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


Fig. 9 - Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature




Fig. 10 - Switching Time Test Circuit




Fig. 11 - Switching Time Waveforms




Fig. 12 - Maximum Effective Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction-to-Case

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


Fig. 13 - Unclamped Inductive Test Circuit




Fig. 14 - Unclamped Inductive Waveforms




Fig. 15 - Maximum Avalanche Energy vs. Drain Current




Fig. 16 - Basic Gate Charge Waveform





Fig. 17 - Gate Charge Test Circuit





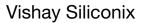
Peak Diode Recovery dV/dt Test Circuit

Fig. 18 - For N-Channel

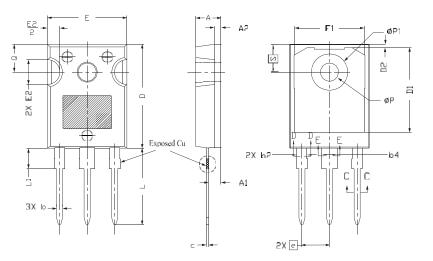

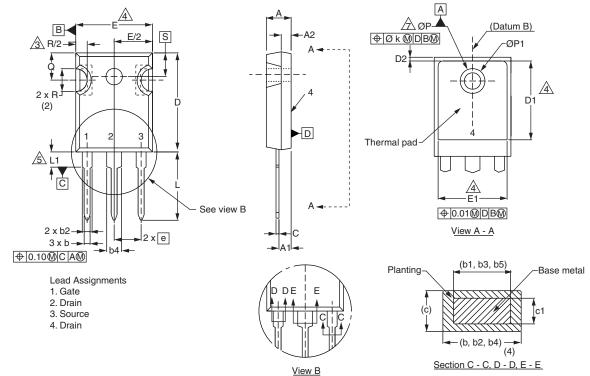

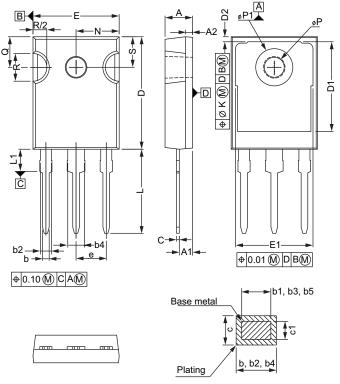
