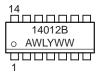

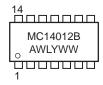


SOIC-14 D SUFFIX CASE 751A

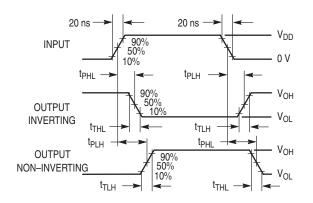
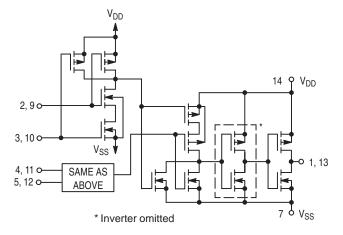


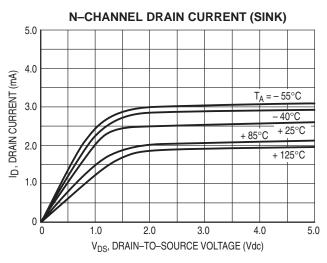
Figure 1. Switching Time Test Circuit and Waveforms

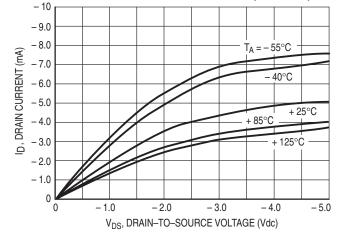
CIRCUIT SCHEMATIC

TYPICAL B-SERIES GATE CHARACTERISTICS

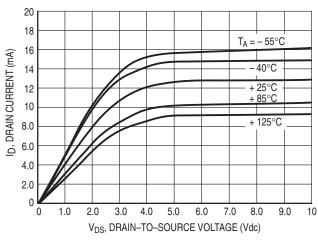




P-CHANNEL DRAIN CURRENT (SOURCE)

Figure 3. $V_{GS} = -5.0 \text{ Vdc}$



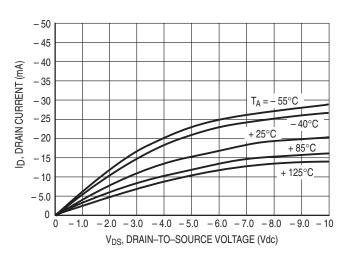
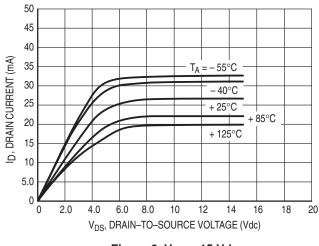


Figure 4. V_{GS} = 10 Vdc

Figure 5. $V_{GS} = -10 \text{ Vdc}$



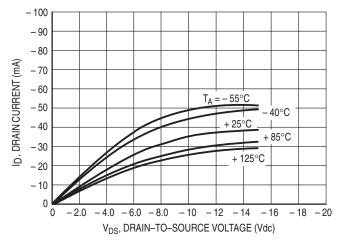


Figure 6. V_{GS} = 15 Vdc

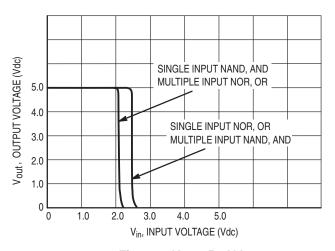


Figure 8. $V_{DD} = 5.0 \text{ Vdc}$

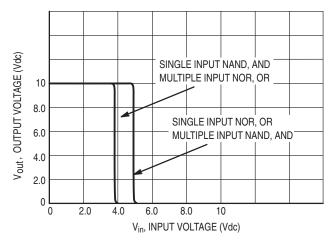


Figure 9. V_{DD} = 10 Vdc

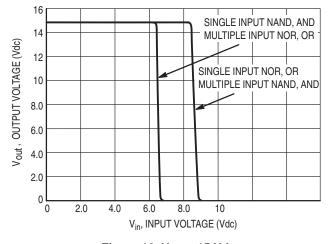


Figure 10. $V_{DD} = 15 \text{ Vdc}$

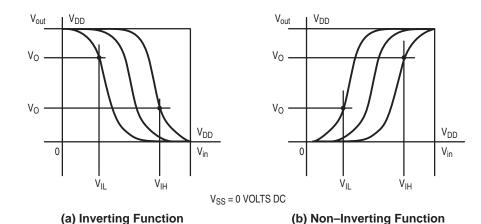
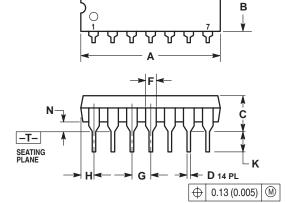


Figure 11. DC Noise Immunity

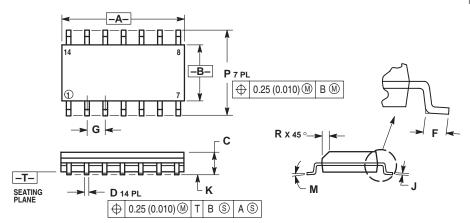

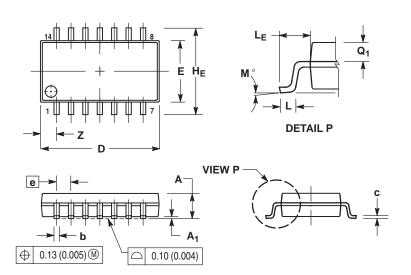

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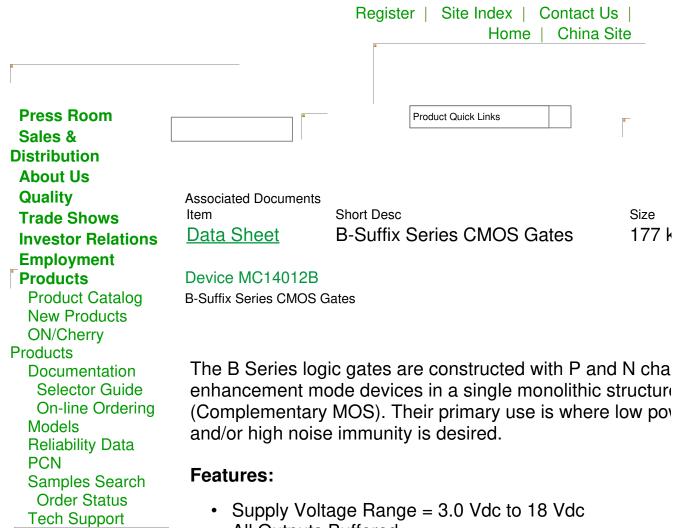
