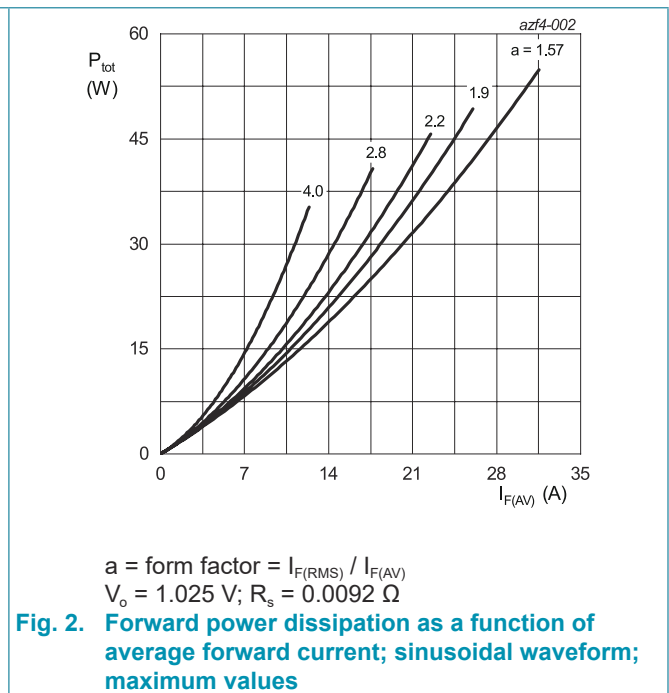

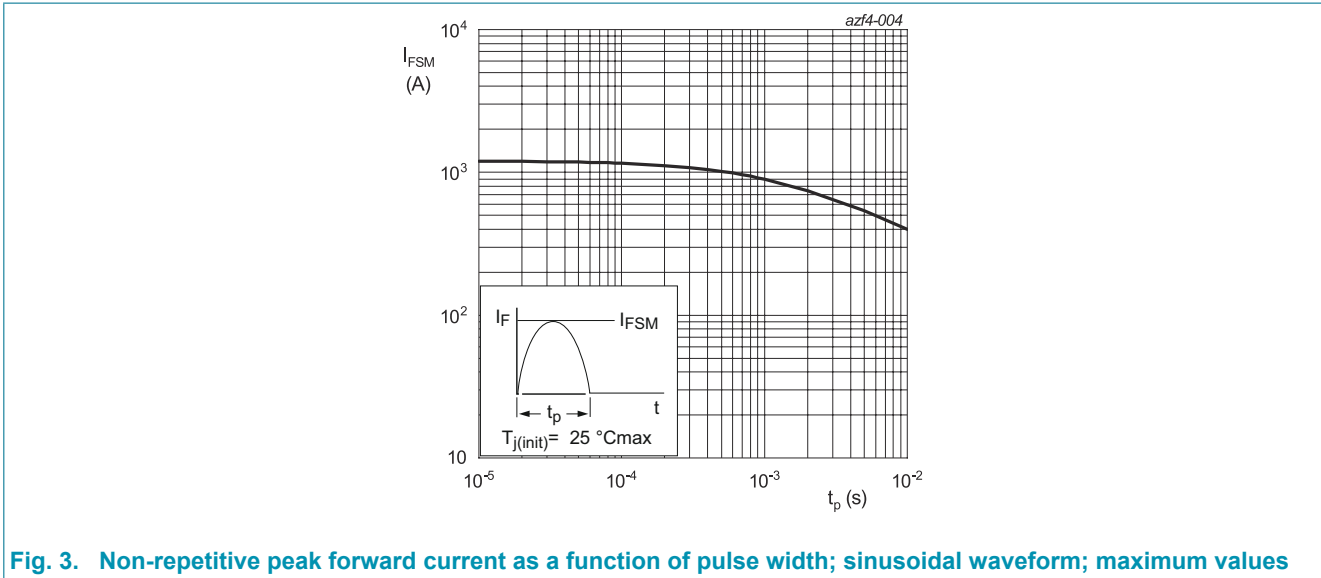


Fig. 3. Non-repetitive peak forward current as a function of pulse width; sinusoidal waveform; maximum values

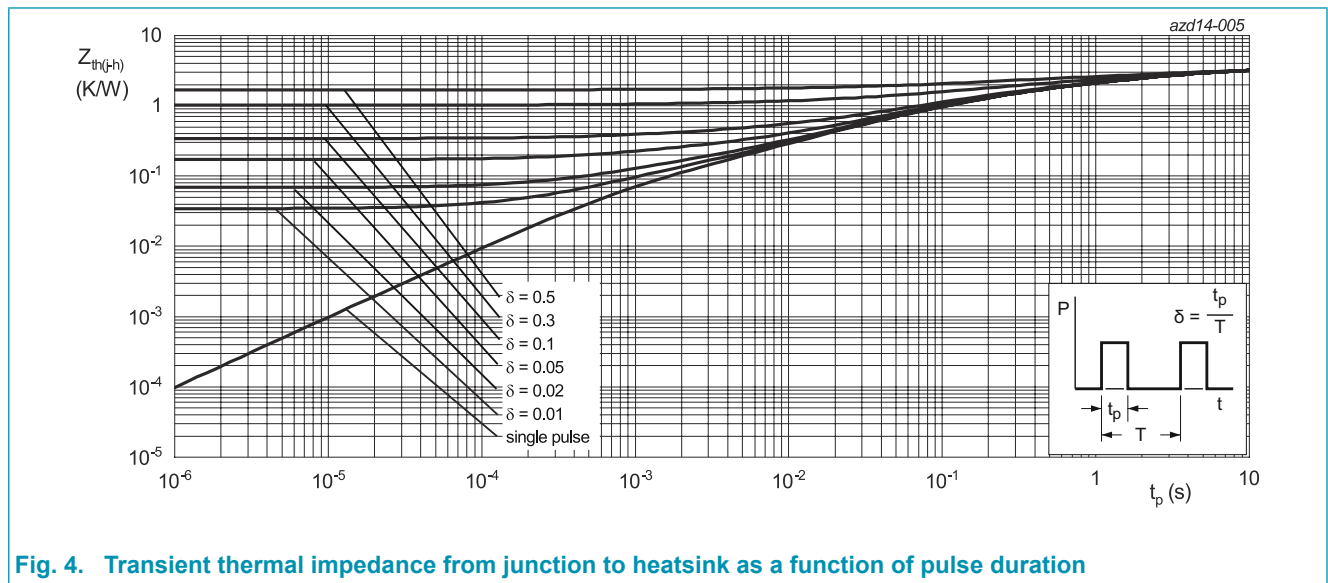


Fig. 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to heatsink as a function of pulse duration

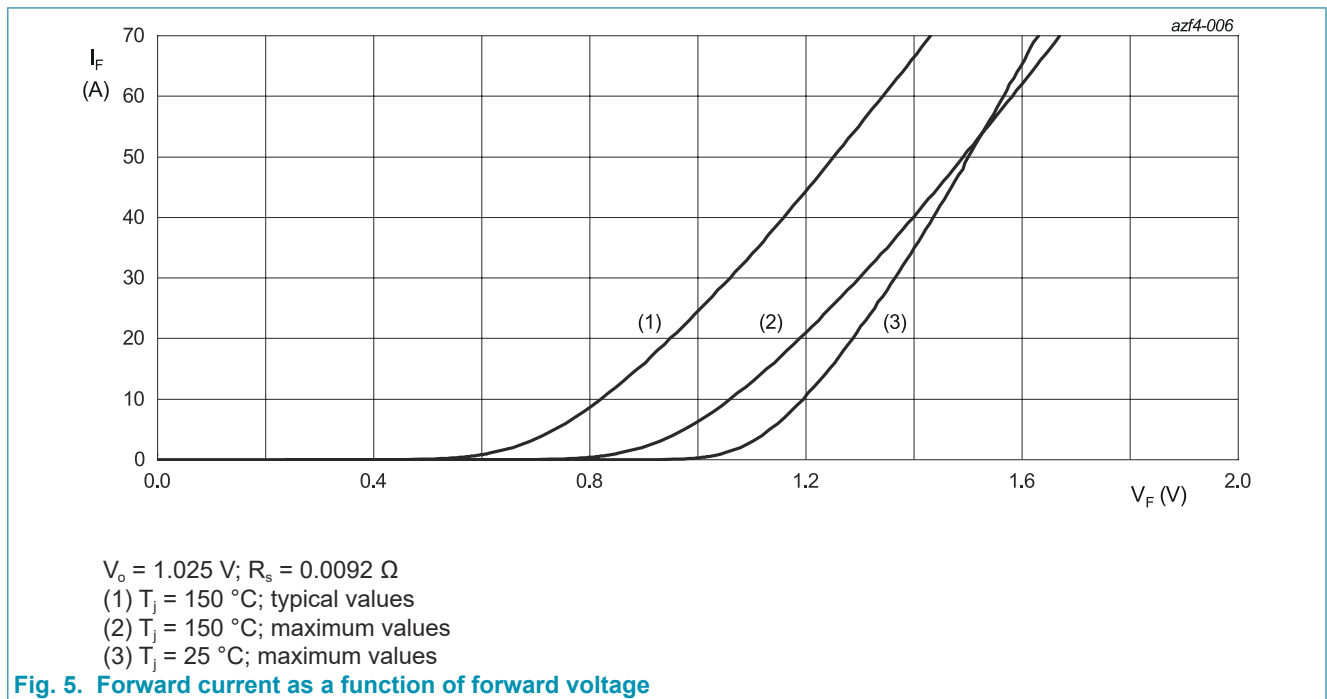

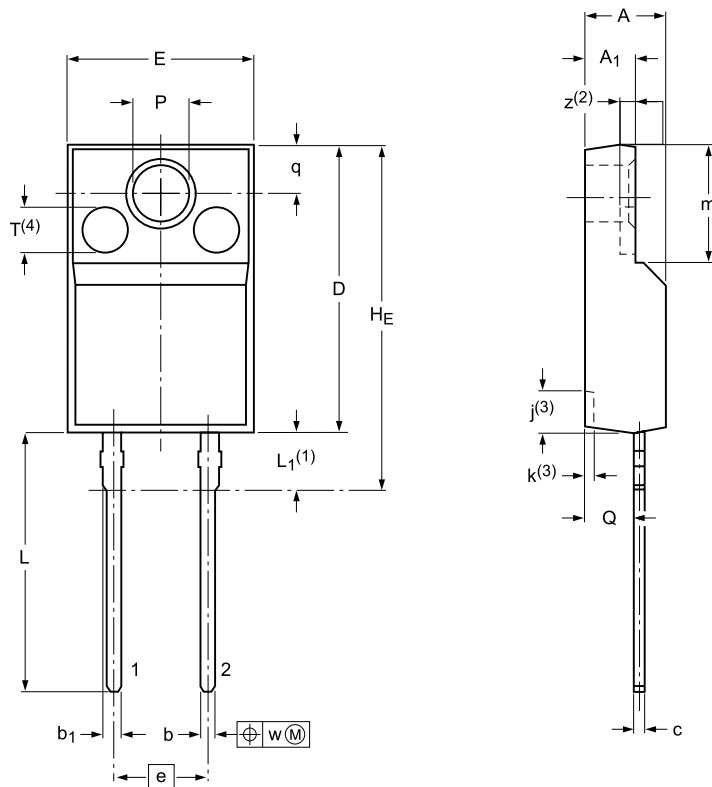
