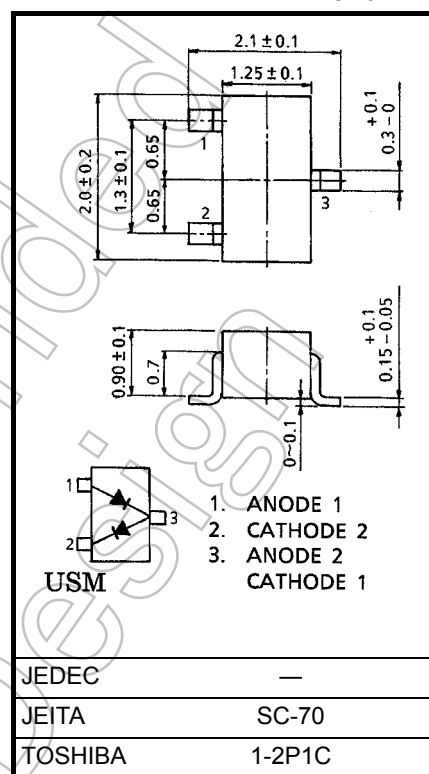
## Ultra High Speed Switching Applications

Unit: mm

- Small package : SC-70
- Low forward voltage :  $V_F(3) = 0.90V$  (typ.)
- Fast reverse recovery time:  $t_{rr} = 1.6ns$  (typ.)
- Small total capacitance :  $C_T = 0.9pF$  (typ.)

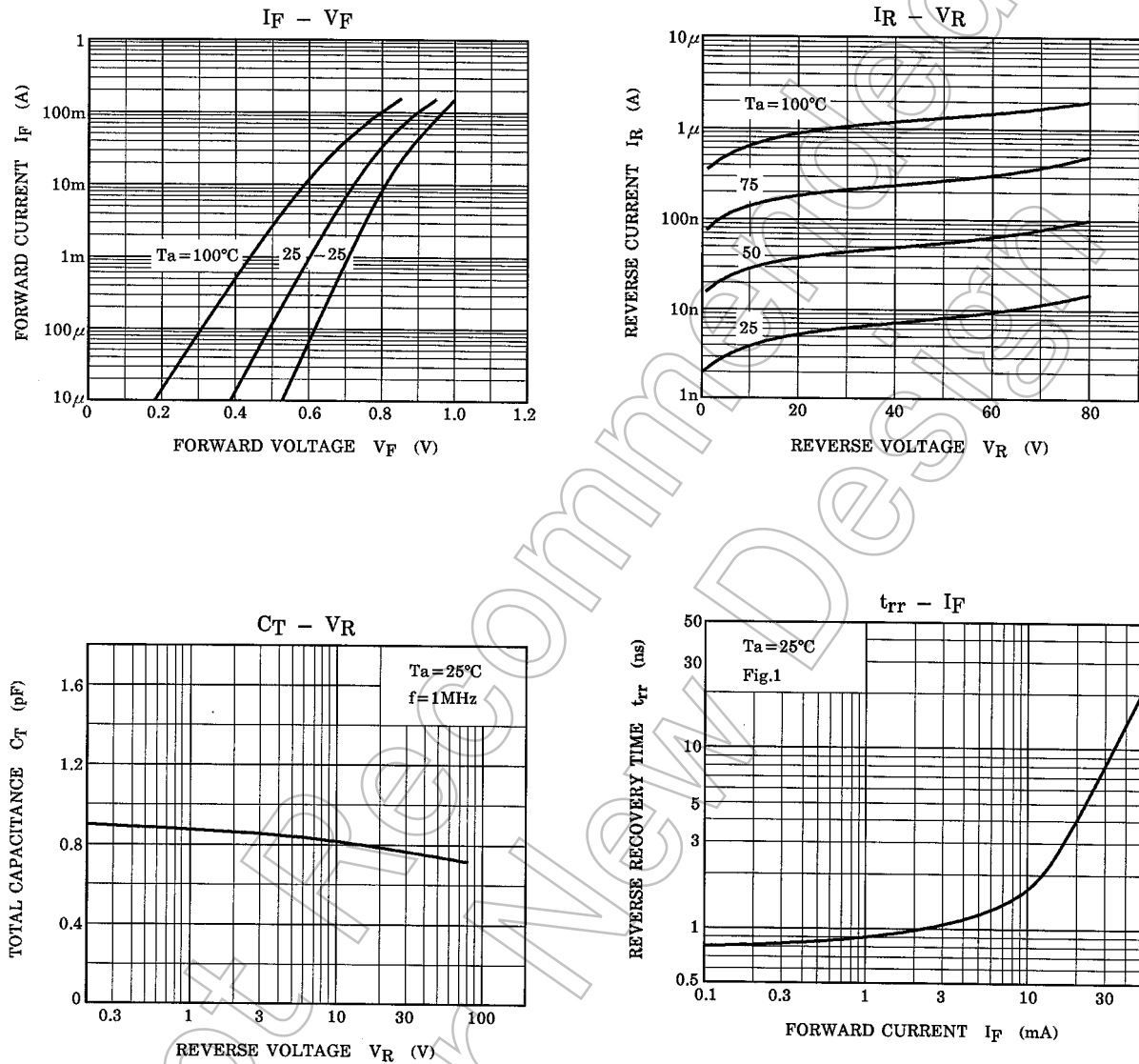
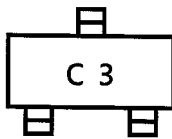
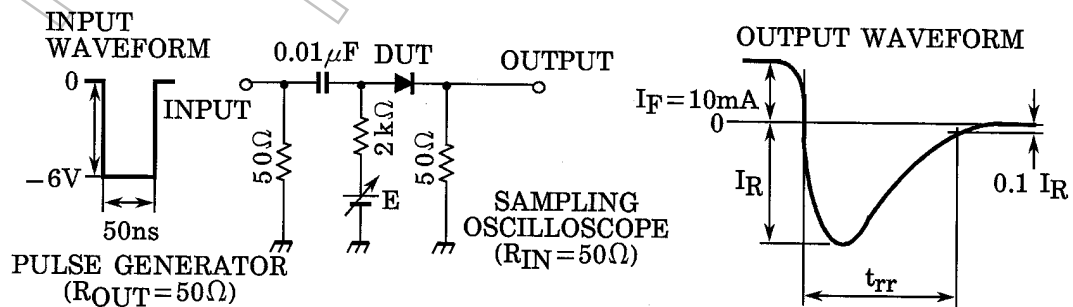


Fig.1 Reverse Recovery Time ( $t_{rr}$ ) Test Circuit



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
