



## Fig.2 Typical Output Characteristics(II)






## • Electrical characteristic curves < MOSFET>



Drain Current :  $I_D$  [A]




## •Electrical characteristic curves <MOSFET>






## •Electrical characteristic curves <Di>


#### Notice
