
TSOT23 6-Lead (SUPERSOT™-6) CASE 419BL








Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics




Figure 2. Normalized On–Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 3. Normalized On–Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




Figure 4. On-Resistance vs. Gate to Source Voltage




Figure 5. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 6. Source to Drain Diode Forward Voltage vs. Source Current




Figure 7. Gate Charge Characteristics




Figure 9. Unclamped Inductive Switching Capability




Figure 11. Forward Bias Safe Operating Area




Figure 8. Capacitance vs. Drain to Source Voltage




Figure 10. Maximum Continuous Drain Current vs. Ambient Temperature




Figure 12. Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation




Figure 13. Junction-to-Ambient Transient Thermal Response Curve


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
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



