


Fig.1 Ground Emitter Propagation Characteristics

Fig.3 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current (I)




Fig.4 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current (II)




Fig.2 Grounded Emitter Output Characteristics





Fig.9 Collector Output Capacitance vs. Collector-Base Voltage Emitter Input Capacitance vs. Emitter-Base Voltage






Fig.10 Safe Operating Area





Fig.12 Safe Operating Area





Fig.13 Ground Emitter Propagation


Fig.14 Grounded Emitter Output Characteristics




COLLECTOR TO EMITTER VOLTAGE : $V_{\text{CE}}\left[V\right]$

Fig.15 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current (I)





Fig.21 Collector Output Capacitance vs. Collector-Base Voltage Emitter Input Capacitance vs. Emitter-Base Voltage






Fig.22 Safe Operating Area






Fig.24 Safe Operating Area




