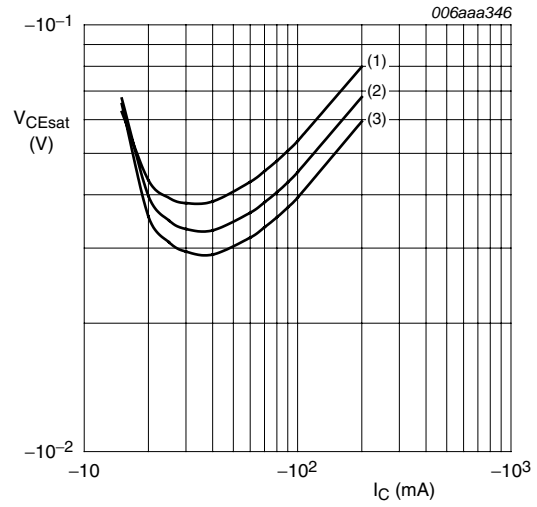

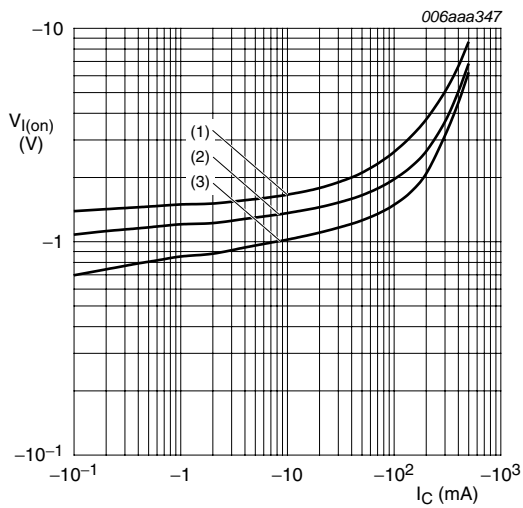

**Fig 1. DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values**



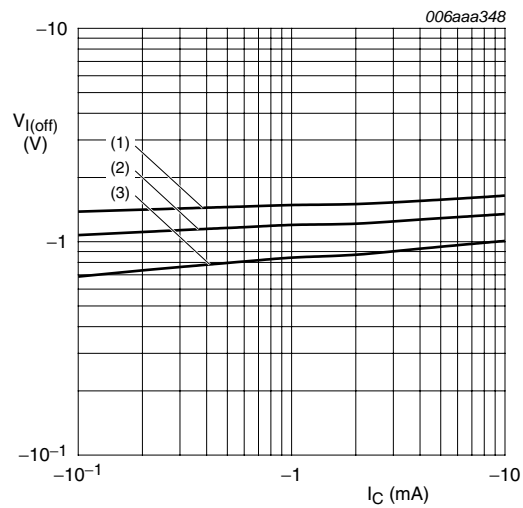

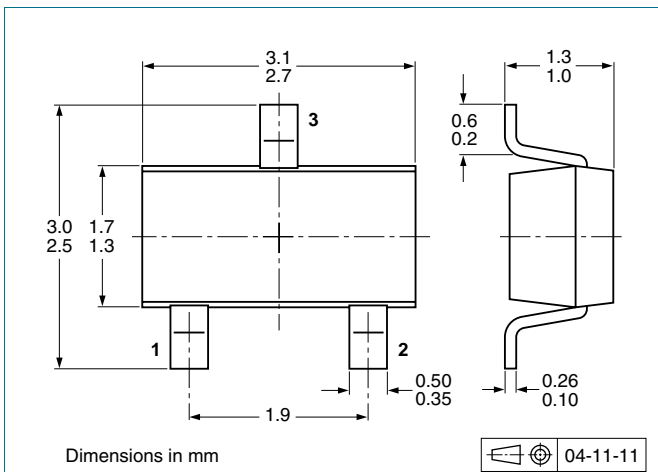
**Fig 3. On-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values**



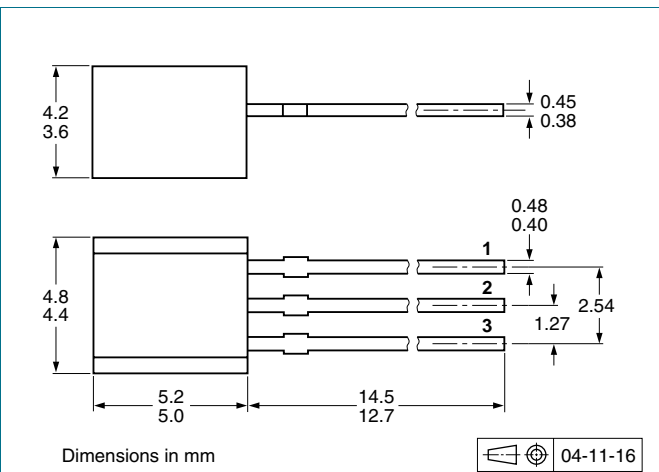

**Fig 4. Off-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values**

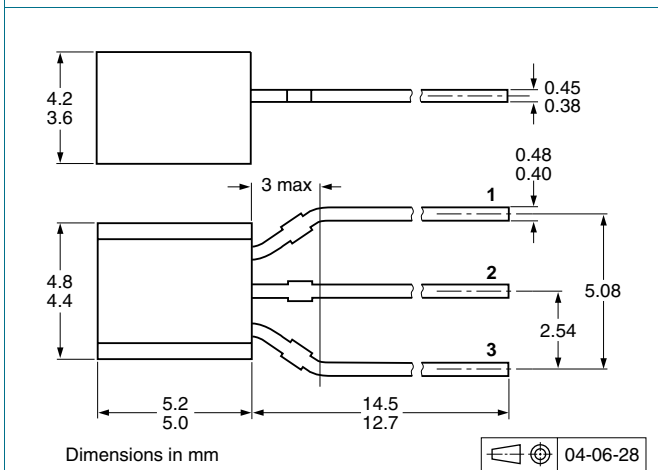

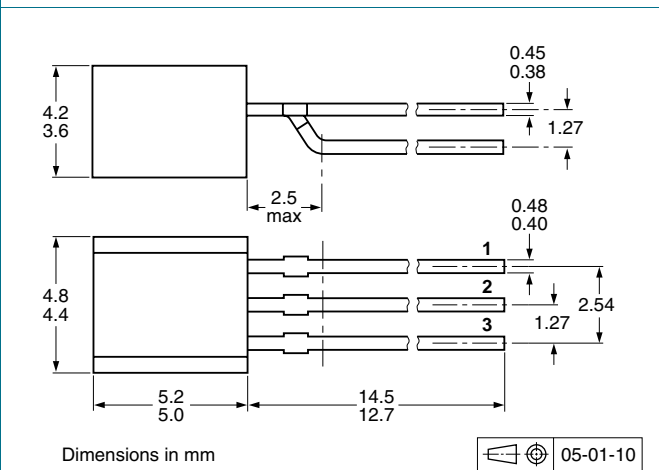
**Fig 5. Package outline SOT346 (SC-59A/TO-236)**



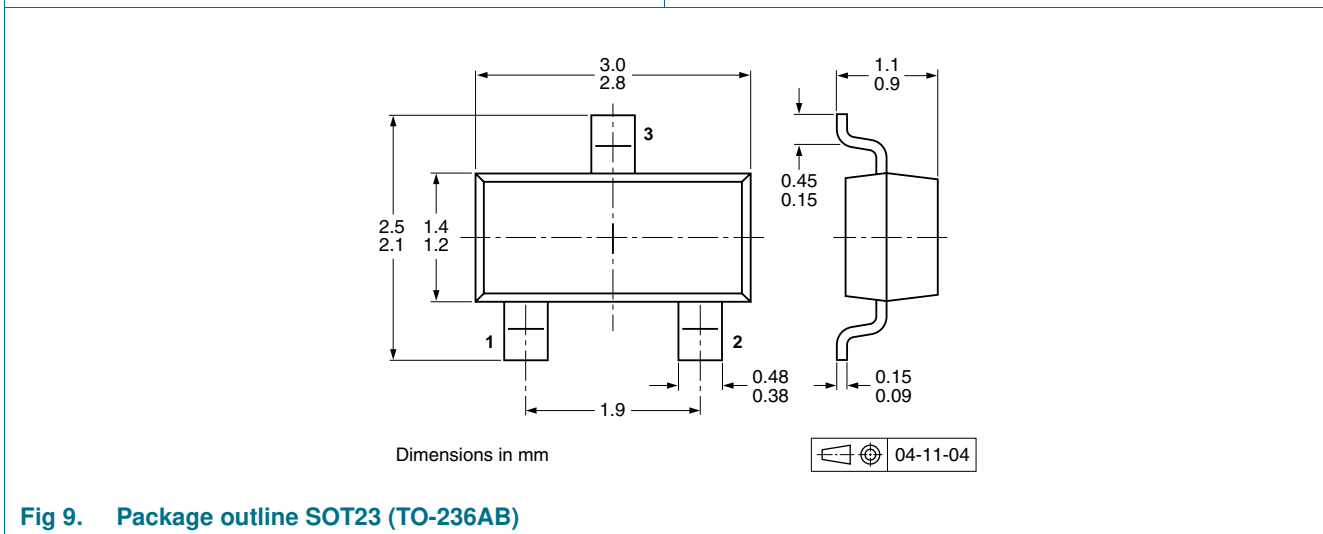
**Fig 6. Package outline SOT54 (SC-43A/TO-92)**
