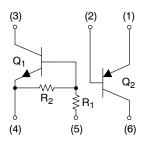

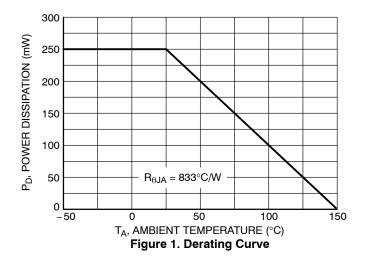

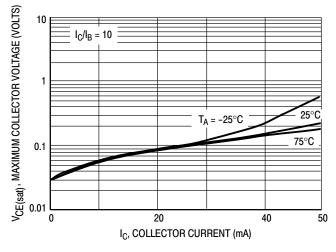


Figure 2. $V_{\text{CE(sat)}}$ versus I_{C}

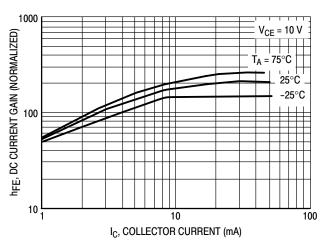


Figure 3. DC Current Gain

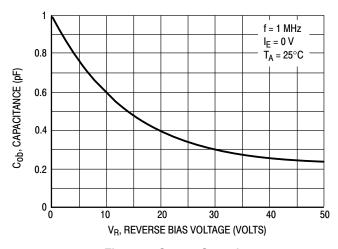


Figure 4. Output Capacitance

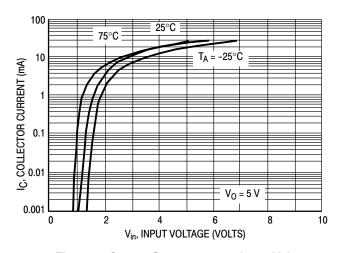


Figure 5. Output Current versus Input Voltage

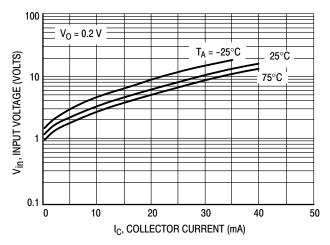


Figure 6. Input Voltage versus Output Current

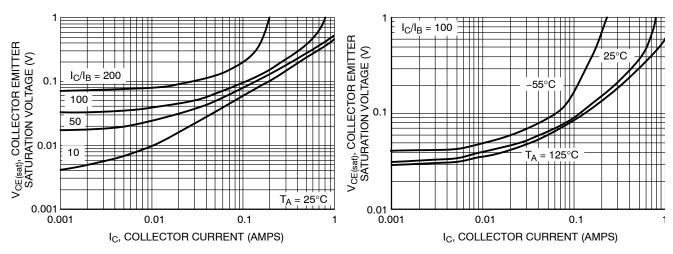


Figure 7. Collector Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current

Figure 8. Collector Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current

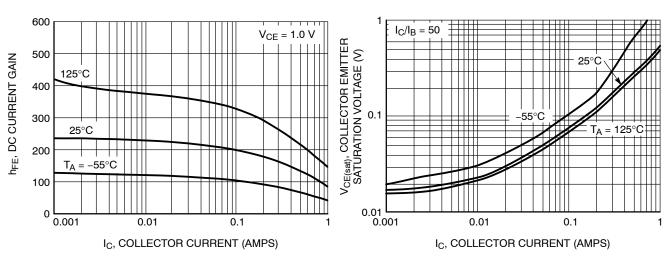


Figure 9. DC Current Gain

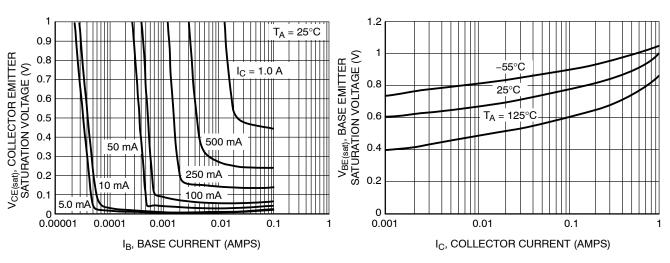
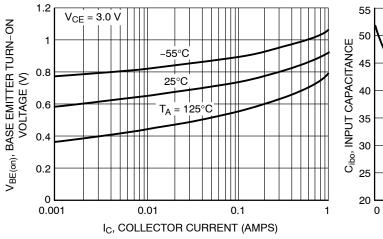


Figure 11. Collector Emitter Saturation Voltage vs Base Current

Collector Current



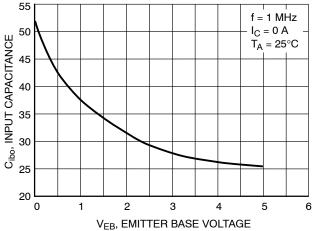


Figure 13. Base Emitter Turn-On Voltage vs. Collector Current

Figure 14. Input Capacitance

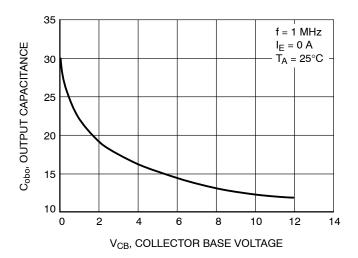


Figure 15. Output Capacitance

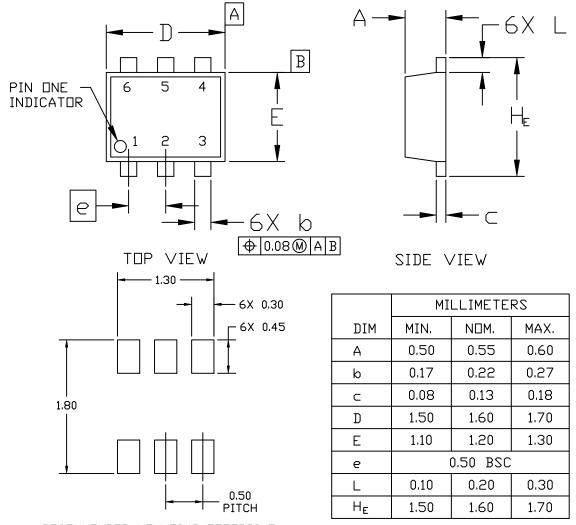
