




Description

The low profile (<1.1mm) of the Micro8 will allow it to fit easily into extremely thin application environments such as portable electronics and PCMCIA cards.

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


Fig 1. Typical Output Characteristics




Fig 3. Typical Transfer Characteristics




Fig 2. Typical Output Characteristics




Fig 4. Normalized On-Resistance Vs. Temperature




Fig 5. Typical Capacitance Vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage




Fig 7. Typical Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage




Fig 6. Typical Gate Charge Vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Fig 8. Maximum Safe Operating Area

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


Fig 9a. Basic Gate Charge Waveform




Fig 10a. Switching Time Test Circuit




Fig 9b. Gate Charge Test Circuit




Fig 10b. Switching Time Waveforms





Fig 11. Maximum Effective Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient

Peak Diode Recovery dv/dt Test Circuit







Fig 12. For N-Channel HEXFETS





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
