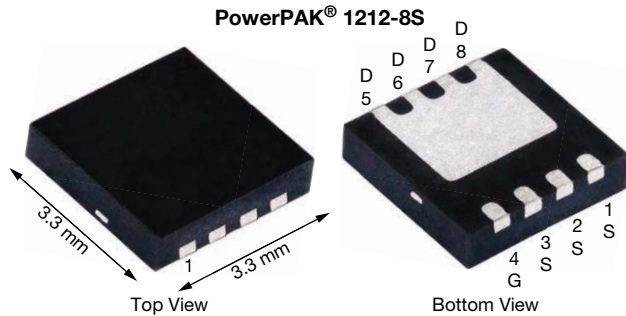

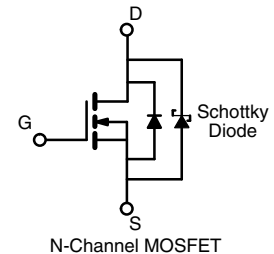

- Maximum under steady state conditions is 63 °C/W

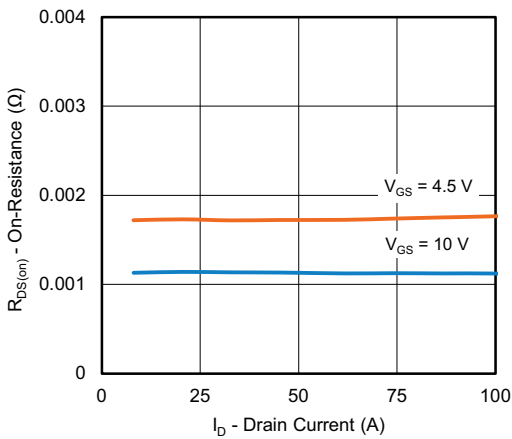

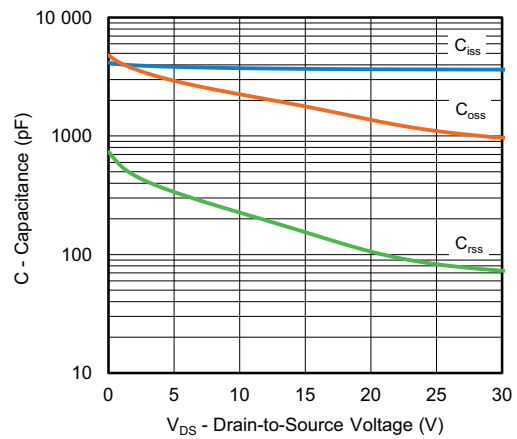

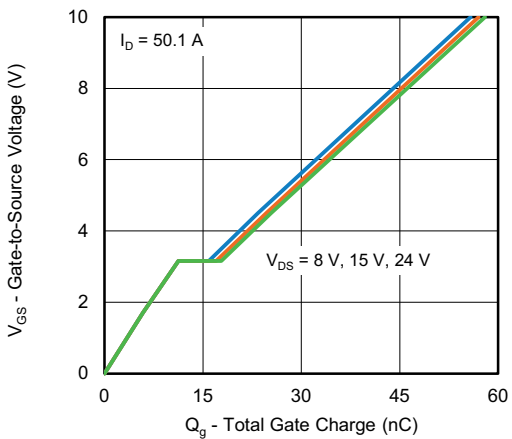
Transfer Characteristics



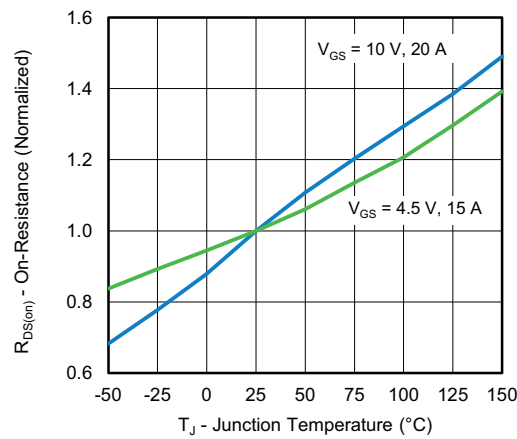
On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage



Capacitance



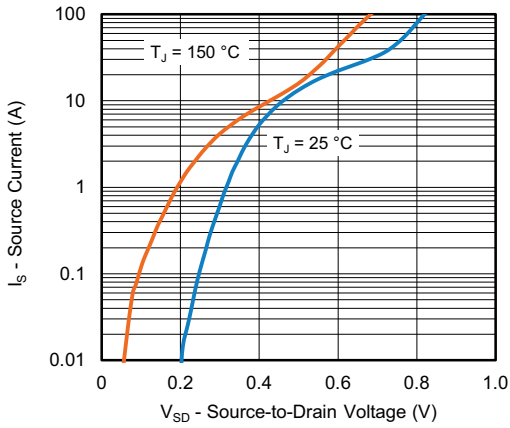
Gate Charge



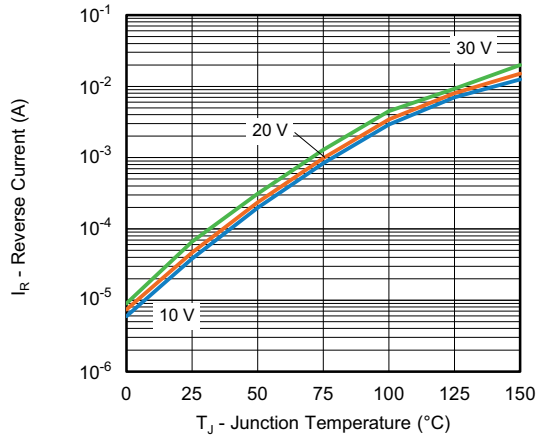
On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature



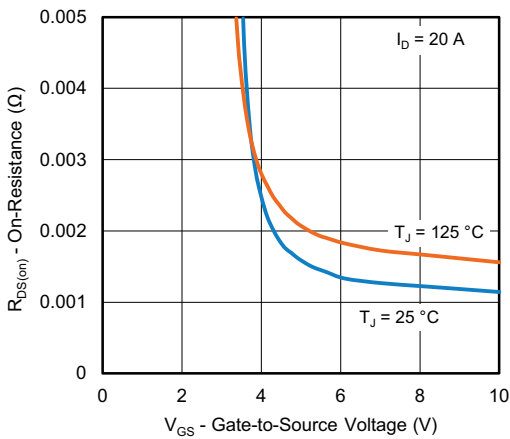

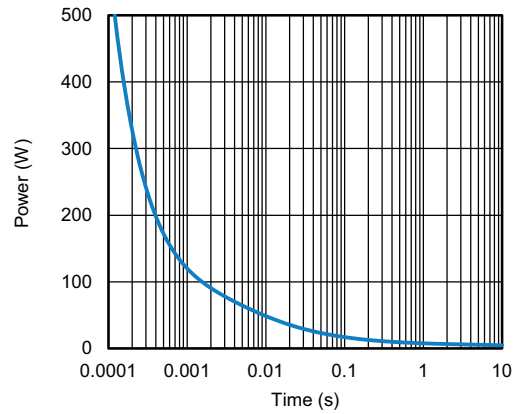
Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage



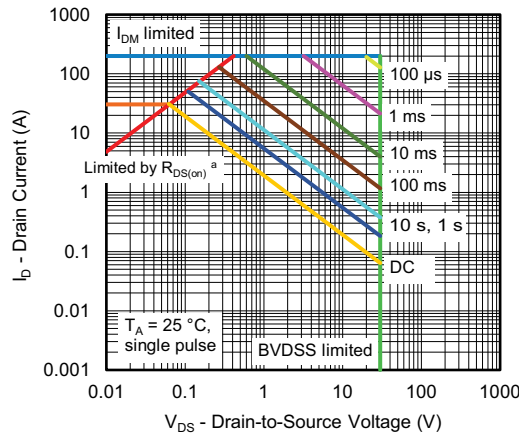
Reverse Current (Schottky)

Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient



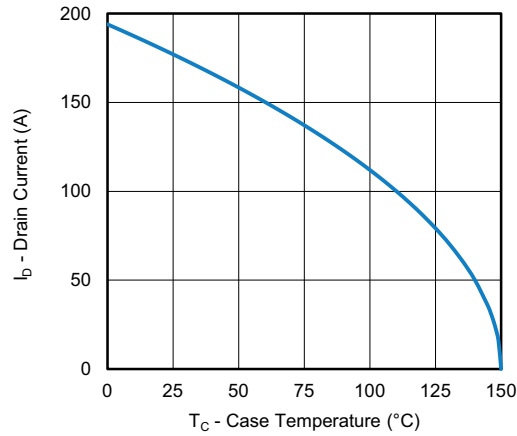
Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient

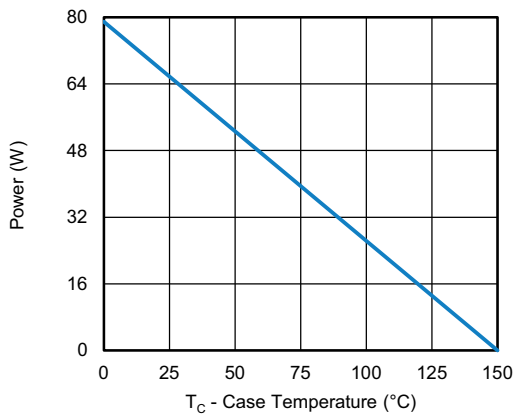

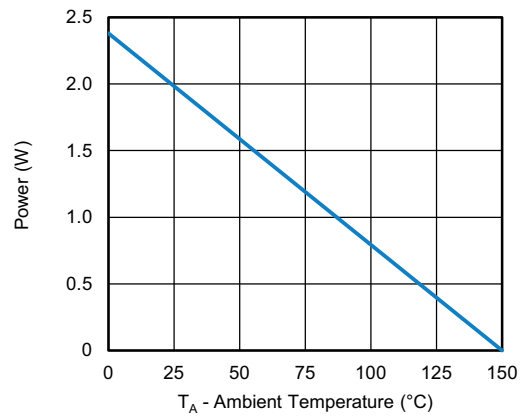

**Power, Junction-to-Case**



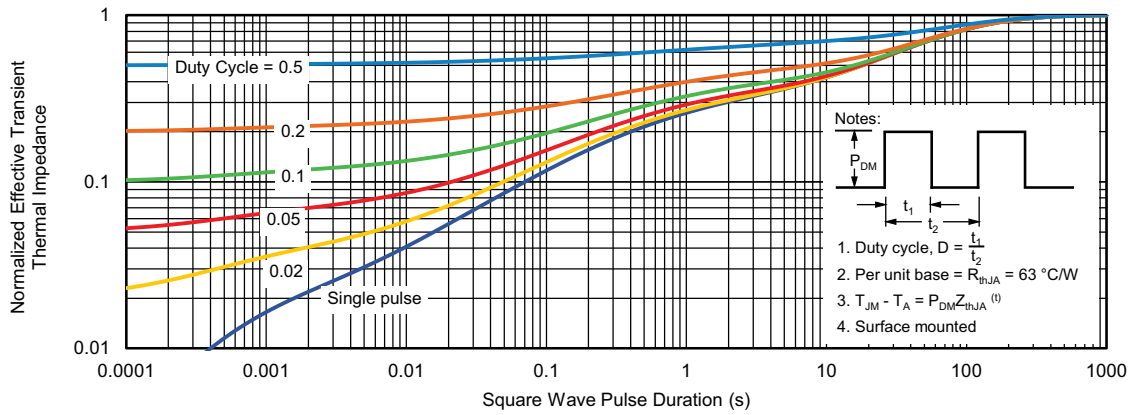

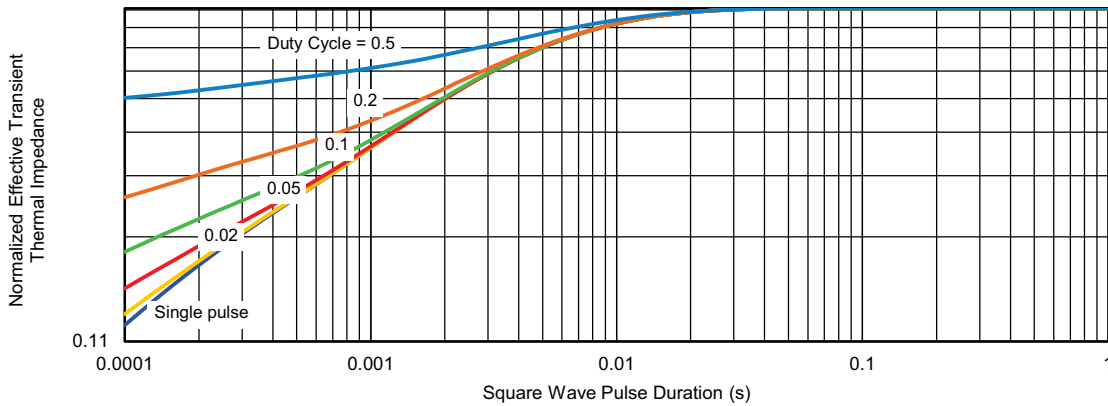

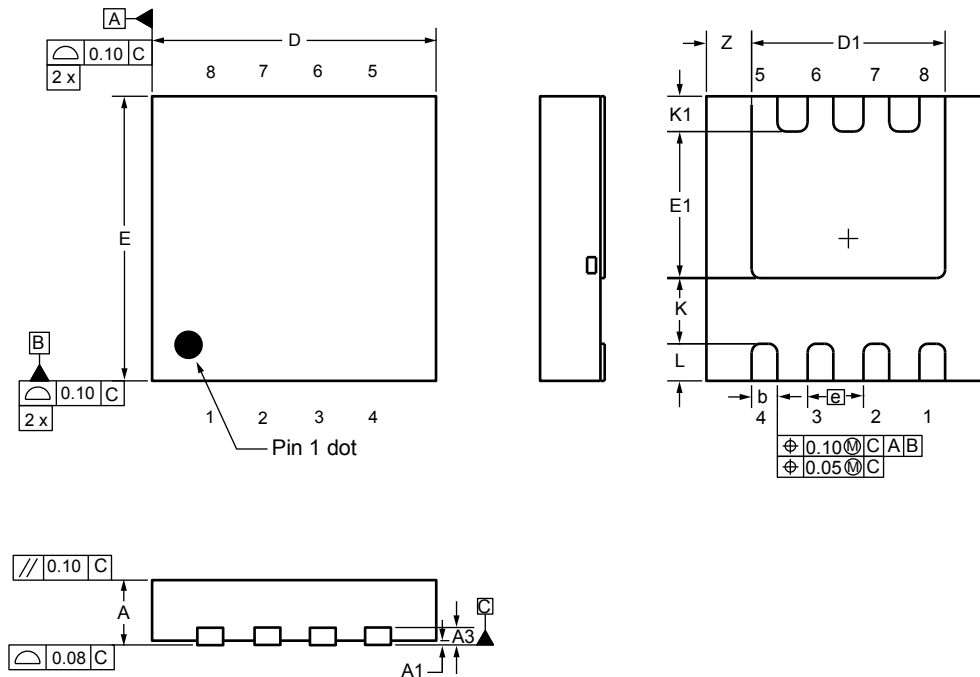
Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient



Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Case

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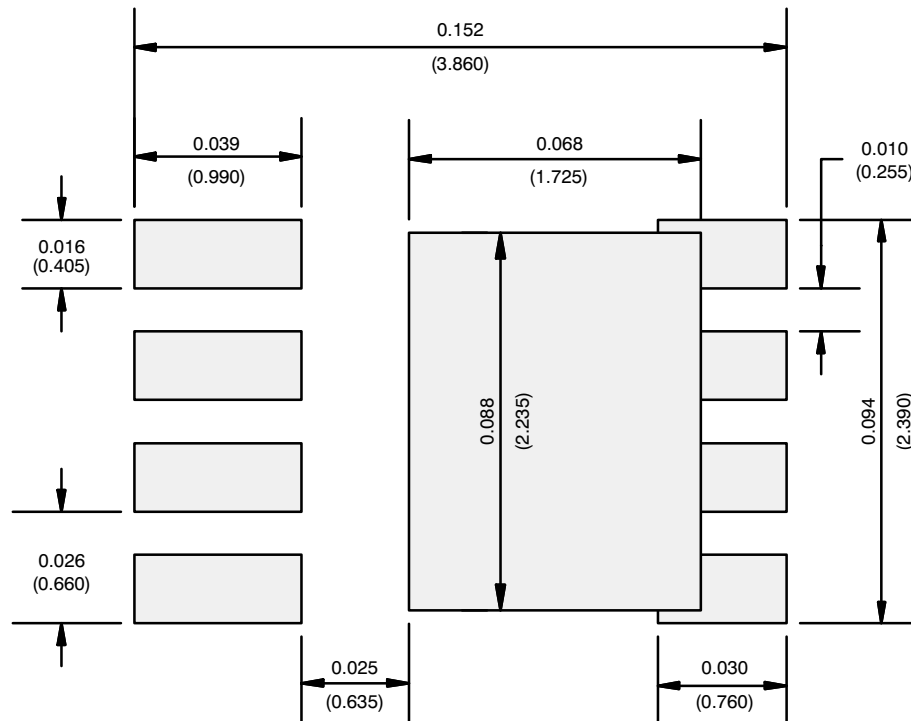
