


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


### **Output Characteristics**



On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Transfer Characteristics




On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature


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
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


## Soure-Drain Diode Forward Voltage






On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage

\*  $V_{GS}$  > minimum  $V_{GS}$  at which  $R_{DS(on)}$  is specified


Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient





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
