- Inductive load driver (e.g. relays, buzzers and motors)

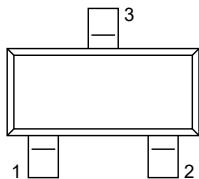
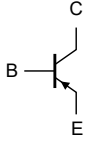

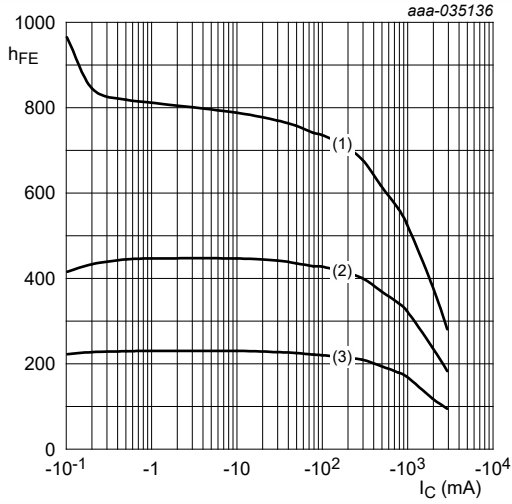

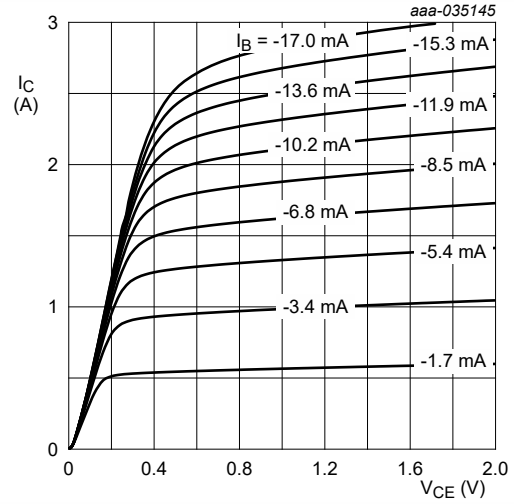

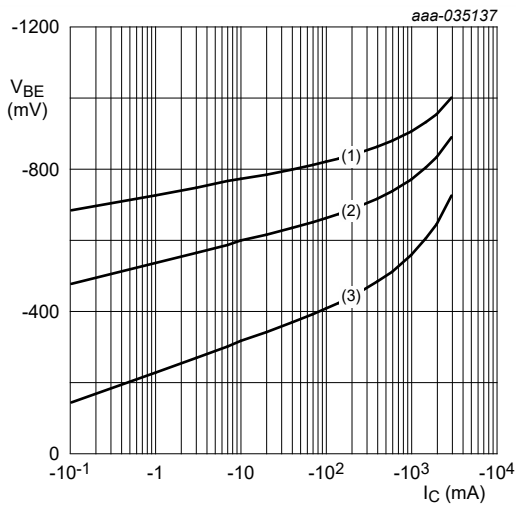

Fig. 1. DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values



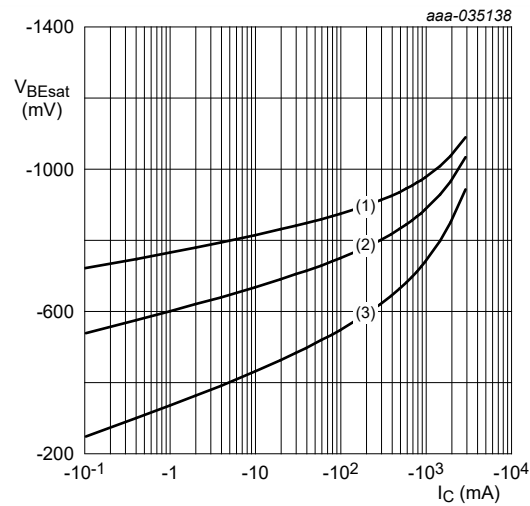

Fig. 2. Collector current as a function of collector-emitter voltage; typical values



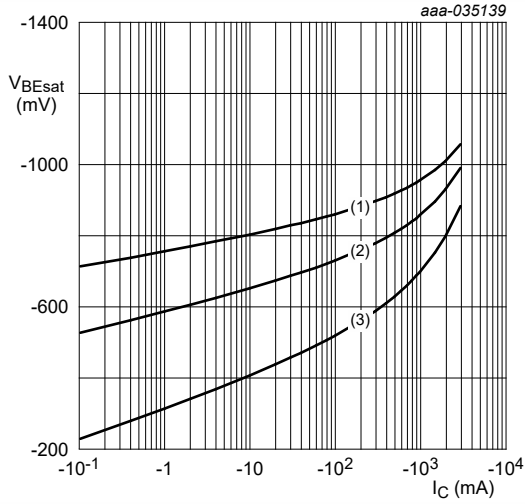

Fig. 3. Base-emitter voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



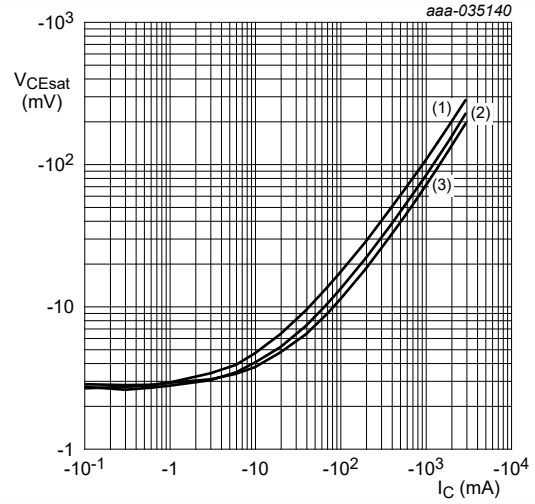

Fig. 4. Base-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



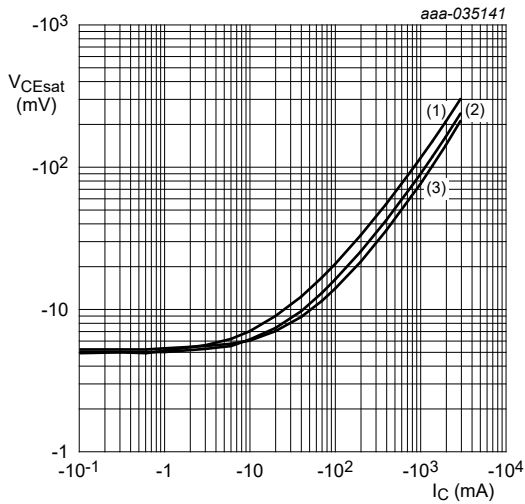

Fig. 5. Base-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



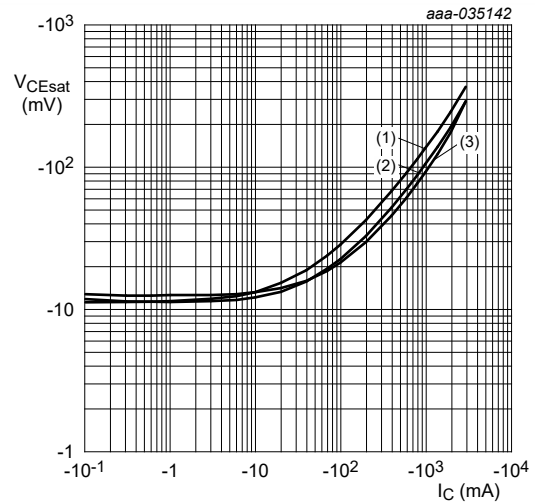

Fig. 6. Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



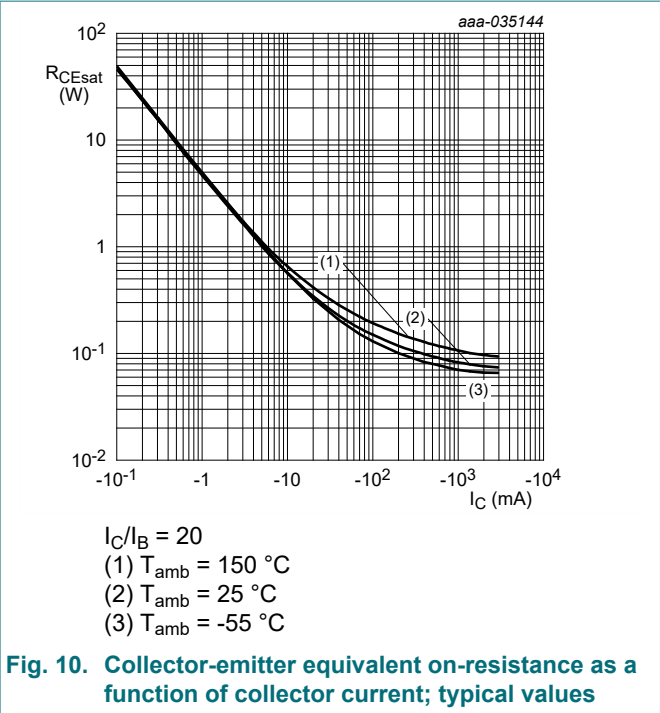
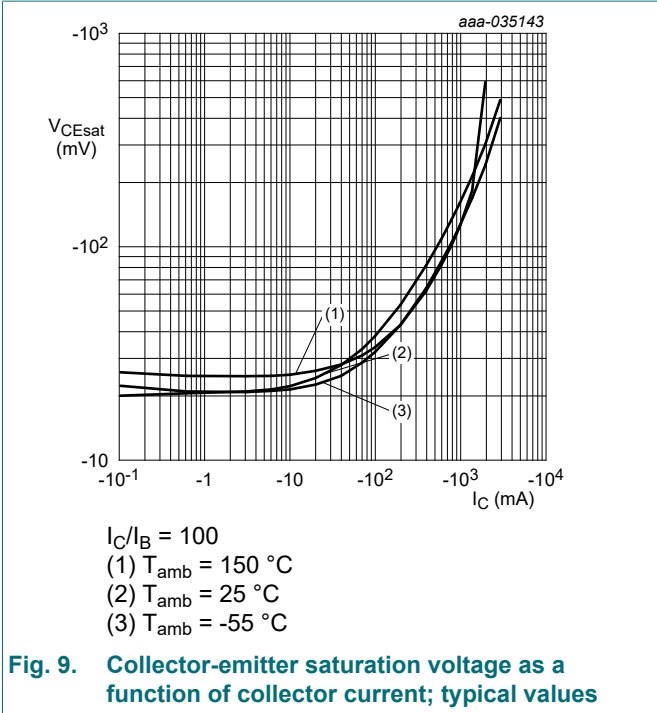

Fig. 7. Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values

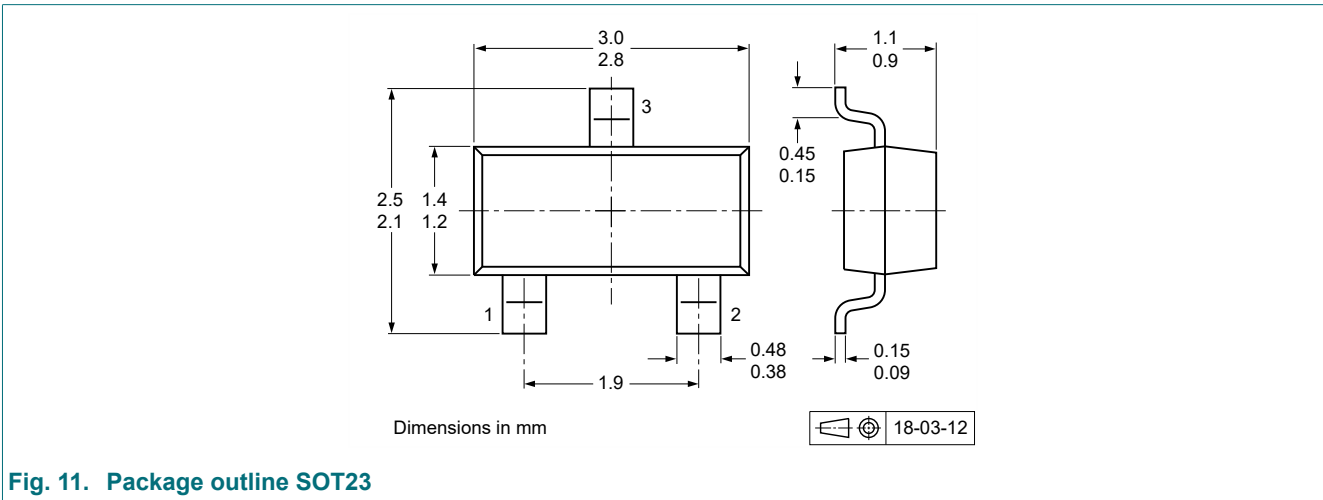

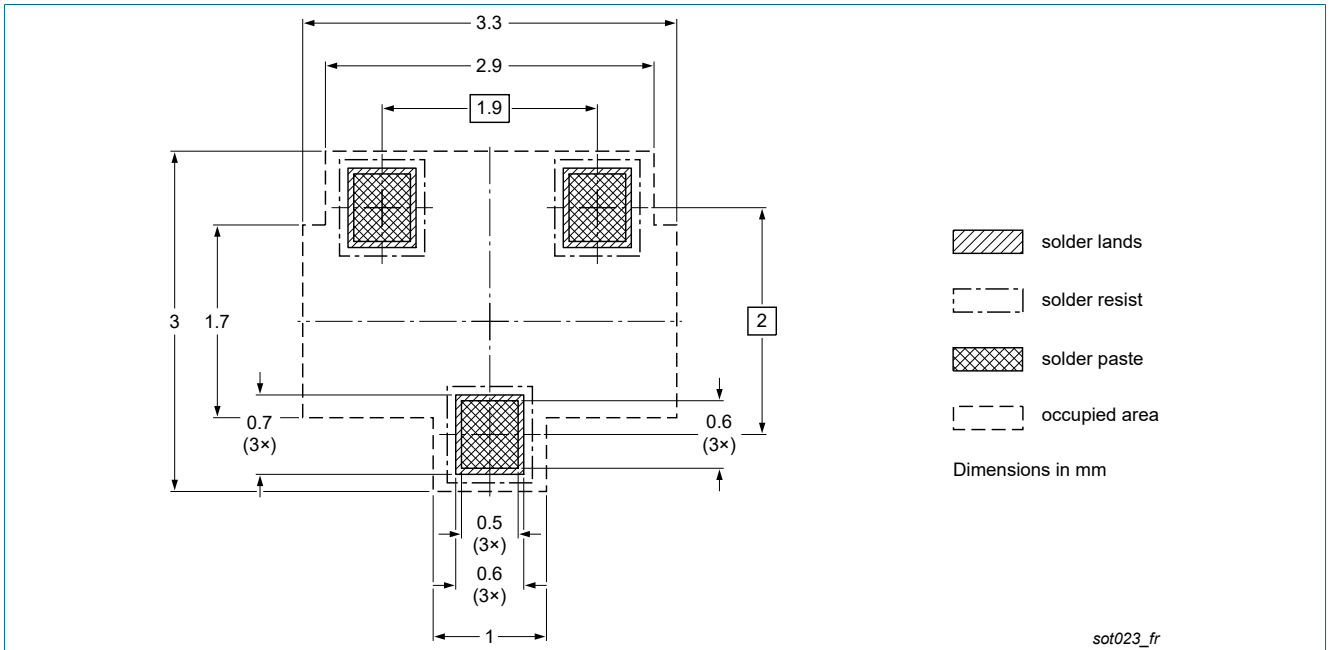


Fig. 12. Reflow soldering footprint for SOT23

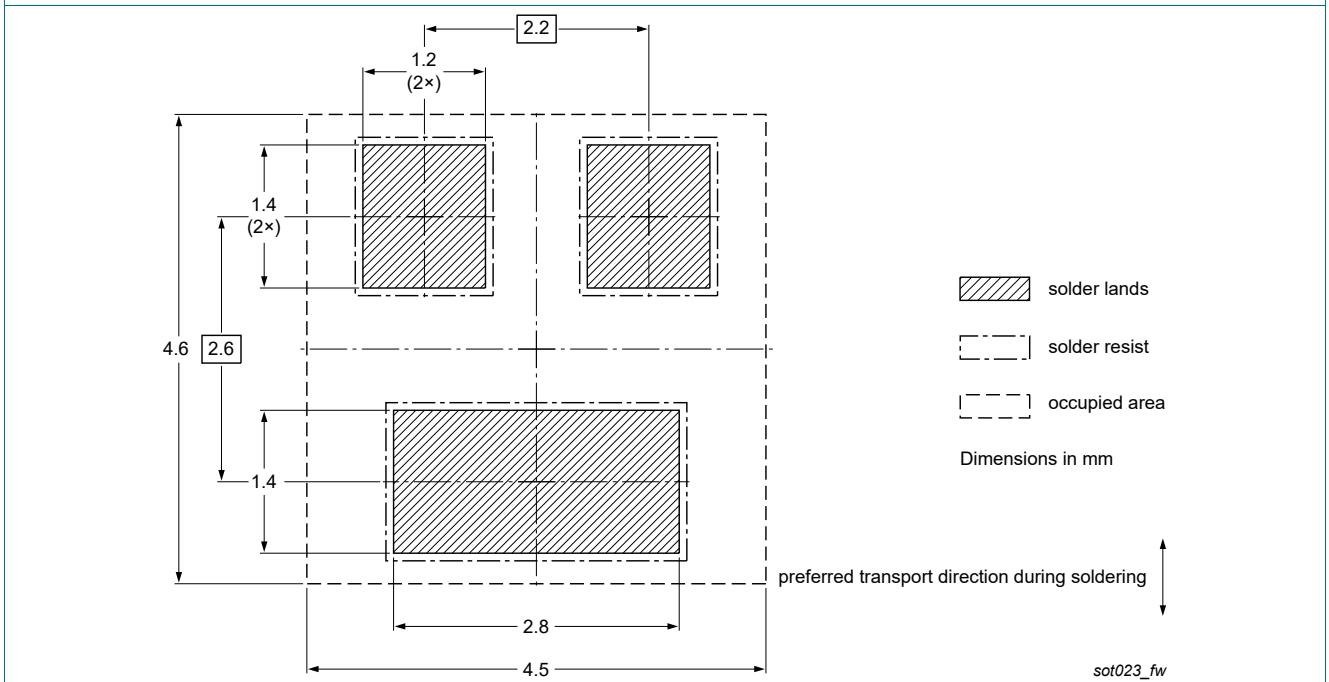


Fig. 13. Wave soldering footprint for SOT23
