1. General description

Extremely low capacitance unidirectional ElectroStatic Discharge (ESD) protection diode in a DSN0603-2 (SOD962) leadless ultra small Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) package designed to protect one signal line from the damage caused by ESD and other transients.

- Unidirectional ESD protection of one line
- Extremely low diode capacitance $C_d = 0.6$ pF
- ESD protection up to ± 10 kV according to IEC 61000-4-2
- Ultra low leakage current $I_{RM} = 1$ nA
- Ultra small SMD package

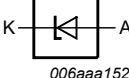

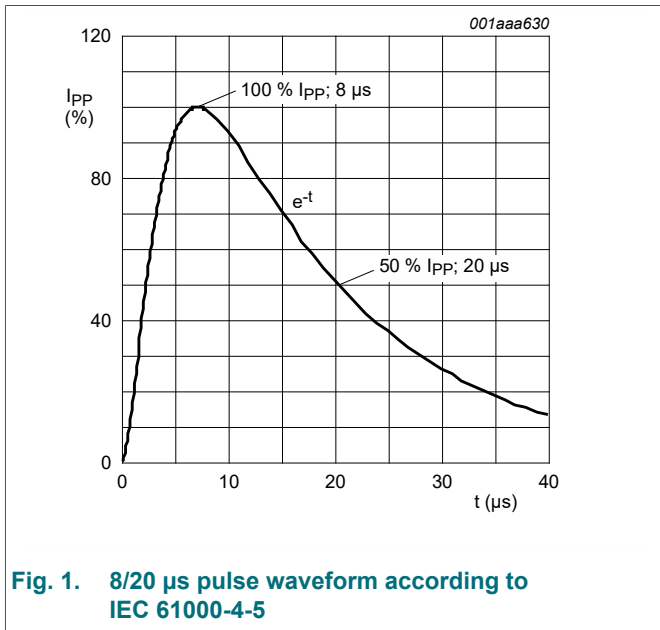


Fig. 1. 8/20 μs pulse waveform according to IEC 61000-4-5

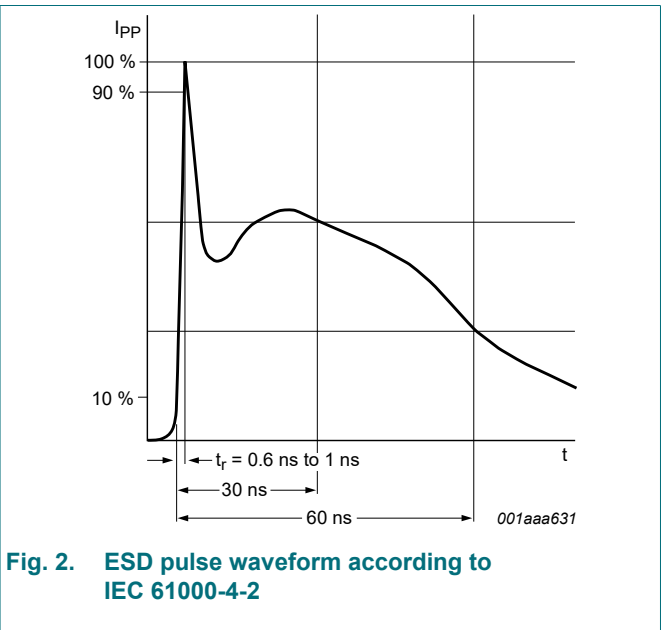


Fig. 2. ESD pulse waveform according to IEC 61000-4-2

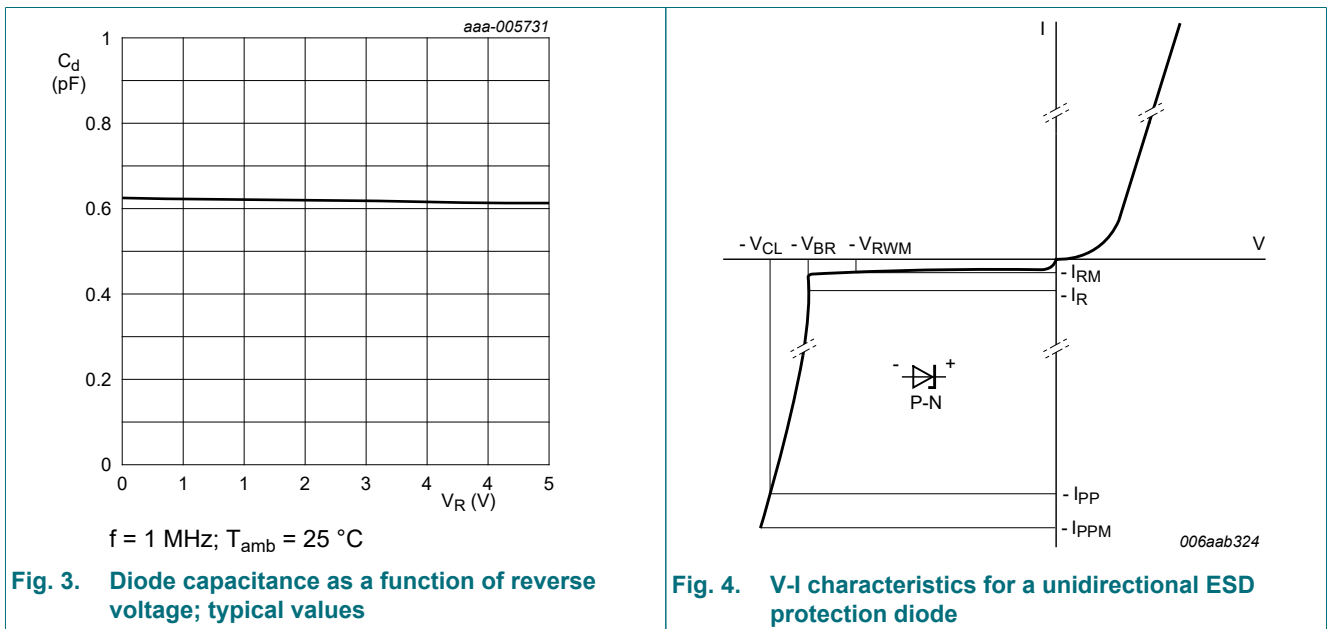
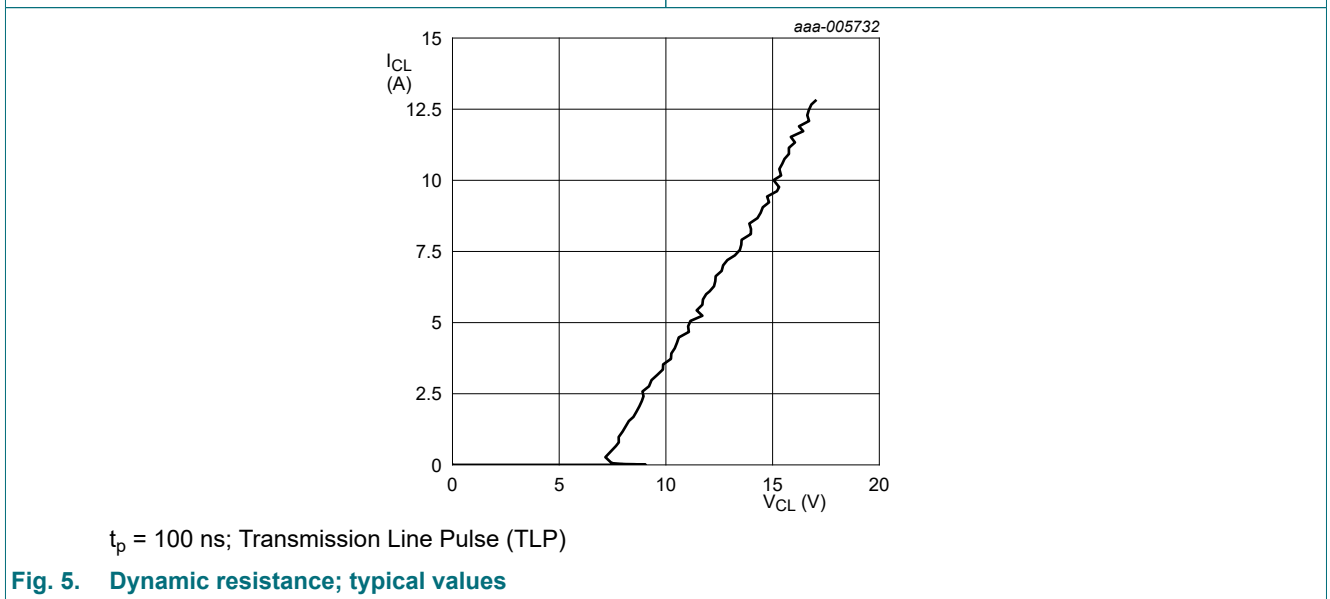


Fig. 3. Diode capacitance as a function of reverse voltage; typical values

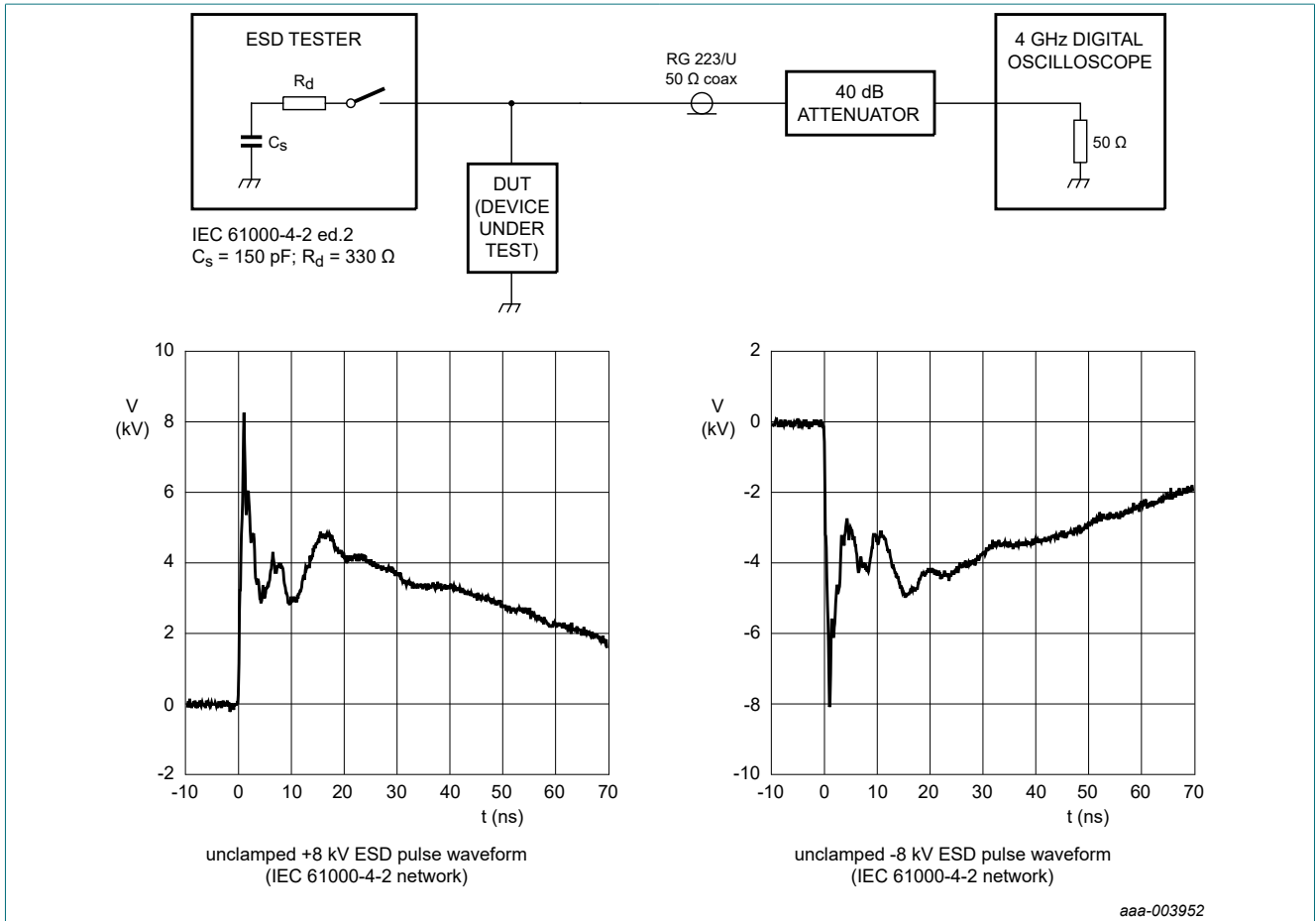


Fig. 6. ESD clamping test setup and waveforms

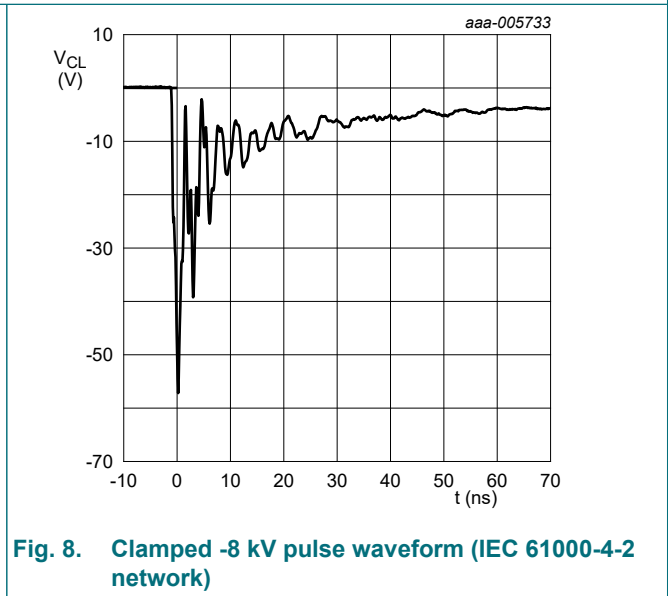
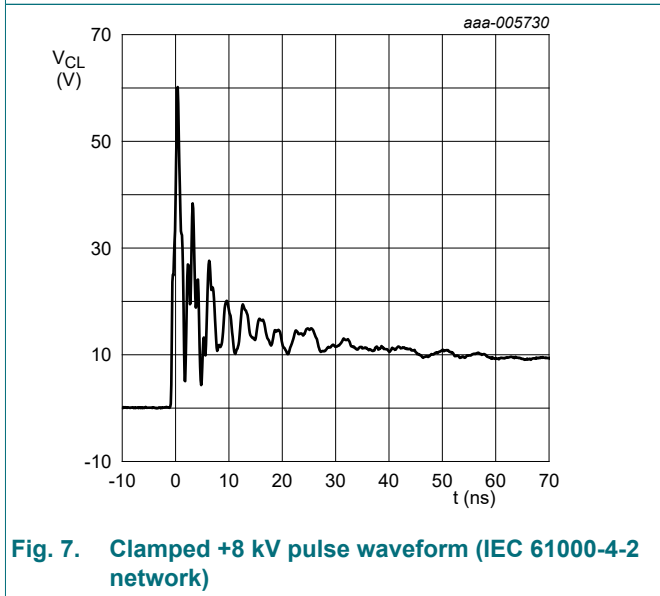


Fig. 7. Clamped +8 kV pulse waveform (IEC 61000-4-2 network)

10. Application information

The device is designed for the protection of one unidirectional data line from surge pulses and ESD damage. The device is suitable on lines where the signal polarities are either positive or negative with respect to ground.

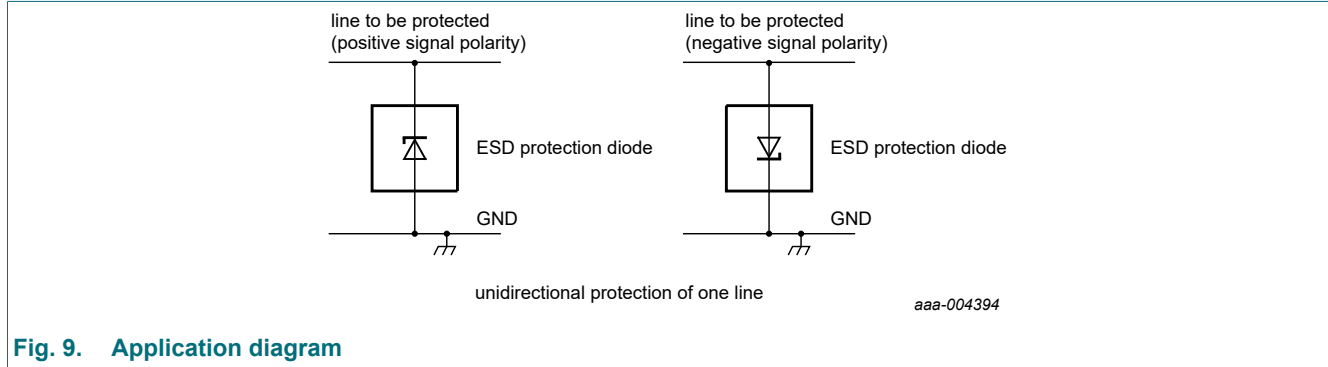


Fig. 9. Application diagram

Circuit board layout and protection device placement

Circuit board layout is critical for the suppression of ESD, Electrical Fast Transient (EFT) and surge transients. The following guidelines are recommended:

1. Place the device as close to the input terminal or connector as possible.
2. Minimize the path length between the device and the protected line.
3. Keep parallel signal paths to a minimum.
4. Avoid running protected conductors in parallel with unprotected conductors.
5. Minimize all Printed-Circuit Board (PCB) conductive loops including power and ground loops.
6. Minimize the length of the transient return path to ground.
7. Avoid using shared transient return paths to a common ground point.
8. Use ground planes whenever possible. For multilayer PCBs, use ground vias.

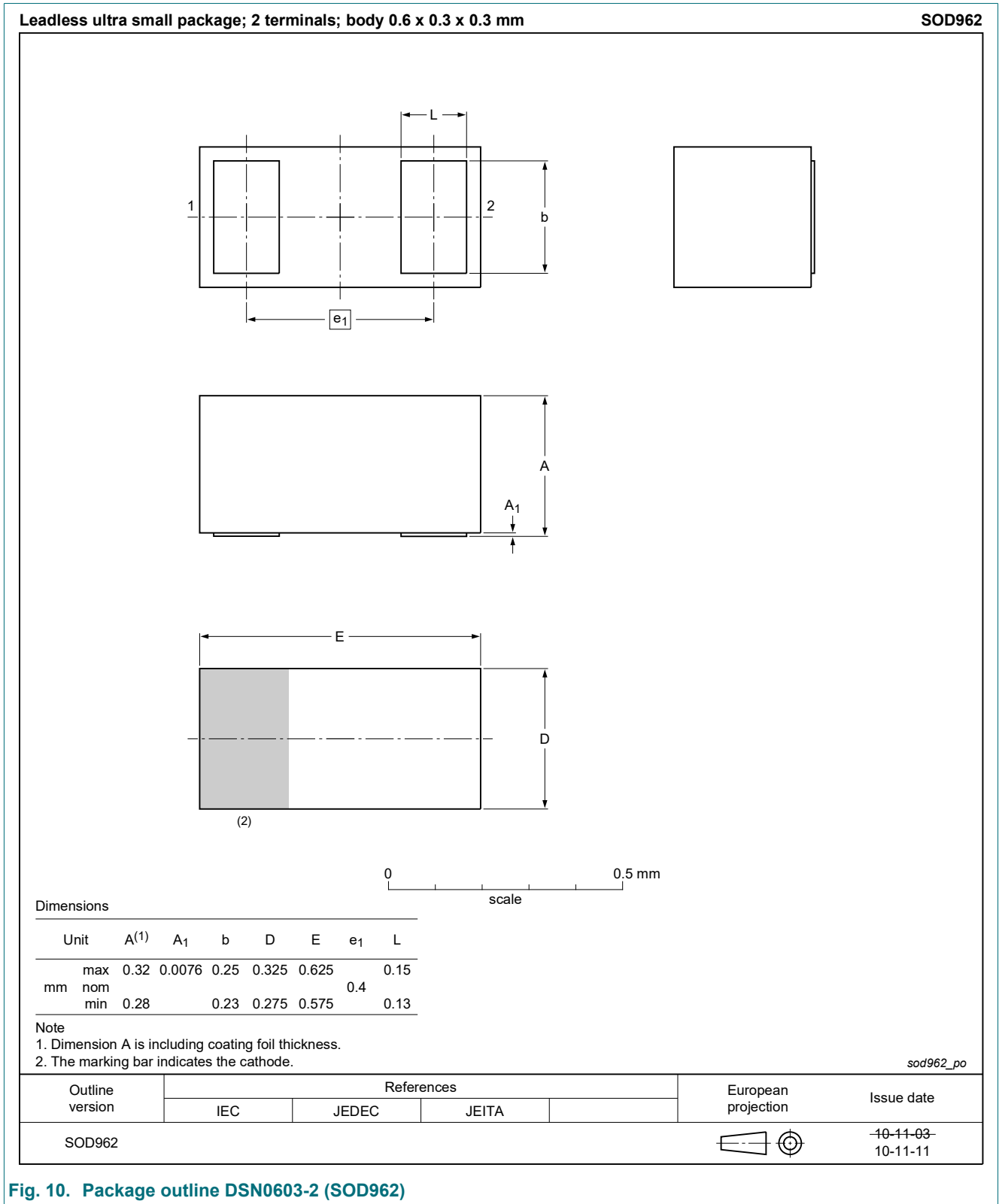


Fig. 10. Package outline DSN0603-2 (SOD962)

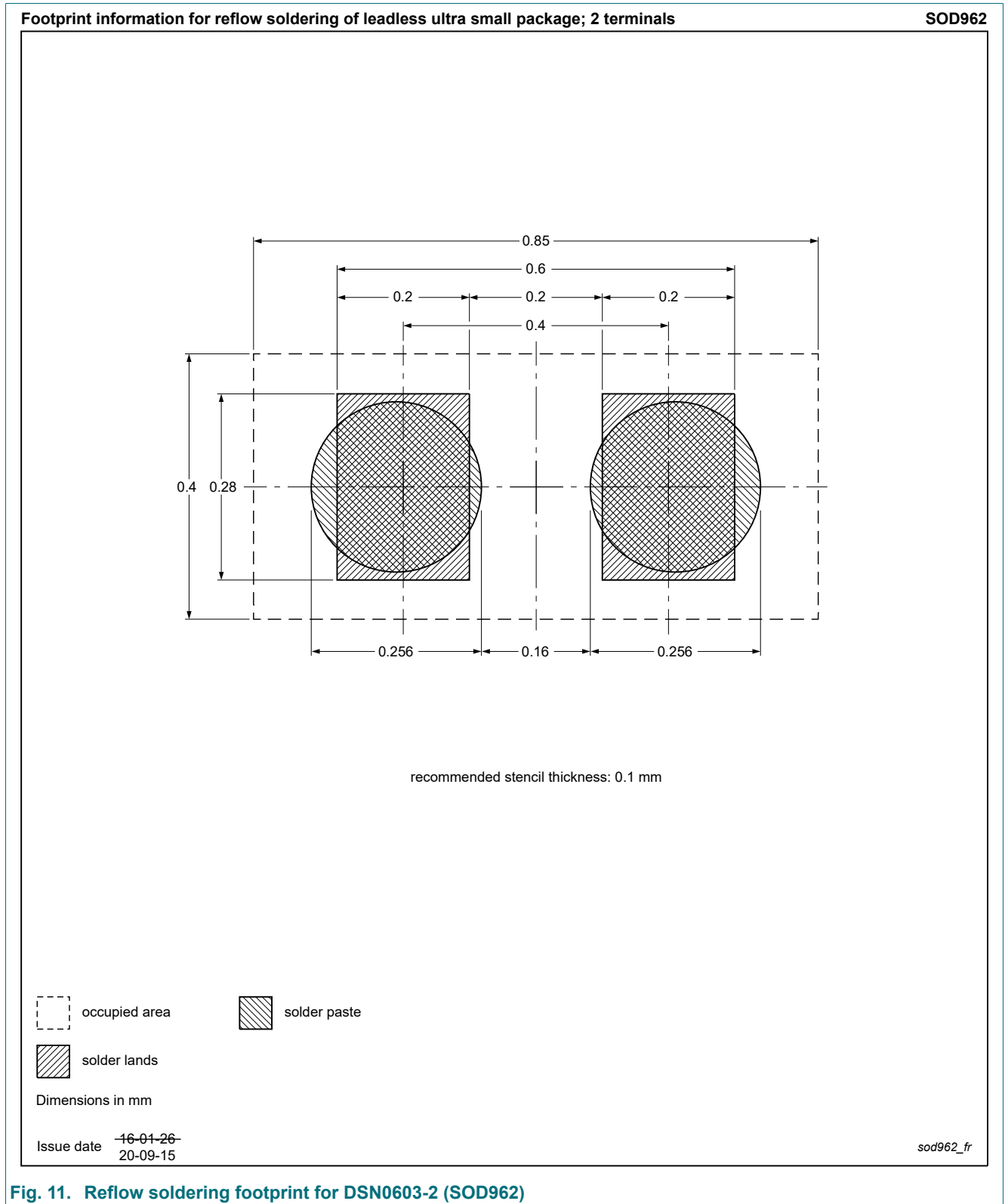


Fig. 11. Reflow soldering footprint for DSN0603-2 (SOD962)
