

#### Description

The NC7SZ19 is a 1–of–2 decoder with a common output enable. The device is fabricated with advanced CMOS technology to achieve ultra–high speed with high output drive while maintaining low static power dissipation over a broad V<sub>CC</sub> operating range. The device is specified to operate over the 1.65 V to 5.5 V V<sub>CC</sub> range. The inputs and outputs are high impedance when V<sub>CC</sub> is 0 V. Inputs tolerate voltages up to 5.5 V independent of V<sub>CC</sub> operating voltage.





Figure 1. SC-88 (Top View)




Figure 2. MicroPak (Top Through View)




#### AC Loading and Waveforms

#### Figure 5. I<sub>CCD</sub> Test Circuit




Figure 6. AC Waveforms



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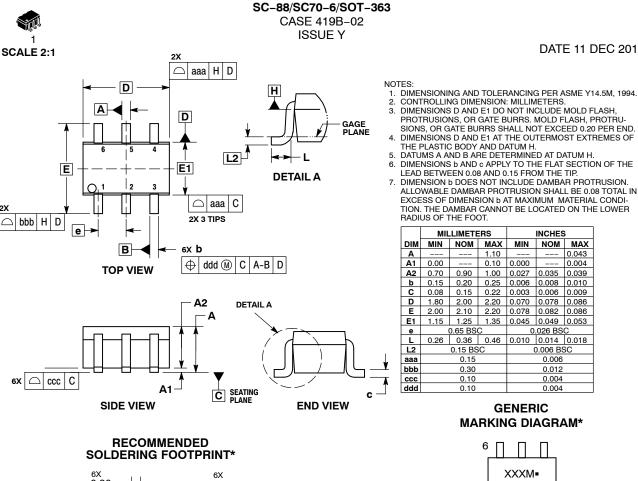


