Ruland MDCD15-4-3-A, 4mm x 3mm Double Disc Coupling, Aluminum, Clamp Style, 15.0mm OD, 23.8mm Length





Description

Ruland MDCD15-4-3-A is a clamp double disc coupling with 4mm x 3mm bores, 15.0mm OD, and 23.8mm length. It is zero-backlash and has a balanced design for reduced vibration at high speeds. The double disc design is comprised of two anodized aluminum hubs, two sets of thin stainless steel disc springs, and a center spacer allowing each disc to bend individually and accommodate all types of misalignment. MDCD15-4-3-A is lightweight and has low inertia making it well suited for applications with speeds up to 10,000 RPM. Hardware is metric and tests beyond DIN 912 12.9 standards for maximum torque capabilities. Ruland manufactures MDCD15-4-3-A to be torisionally rigid and an excellent fit for precise positioning stepper servo applications commonly found in semiconductor, solar, printing, machine tool, and test and measurement systems. It is machined from solid bar stock that is sourced exclusively from North American mills and RoHS3 and REACH compliant. MDCD15-4-3-A is manufactured in our Marlborough, MA factory under strict controls using proprietary processes.

Installation Instructions				
	 Align the bores of the MDCD15-4-3-A double disc coupling on the shafts that are to be joined and determine if the misalignment parameters are within the limits of the coupling. (<i>Angular Misialignment:</i> 1.0°, <i>Parallel Misalignment:</i> 0.05 mm, <i>Axial Motion:</i> 0.10 mm) Fully tighten the M2 screw on the first hub to the recommended seating torque of 0.6 Nm using a 1.5 mm hex torque wrench. Before tightening the screw on the second hub, rotate the coupling by hand to allow it to reach its free length. Tighten the screw on the second hub to the recommended seating torque. Make sure the coupling remains axially relaxed and the misalignment angle remains centered along the length of the coupling. The shafts may extend into the relieved portion of the bore as long as it does not exceed the shaft penetration length of 11.6 mm.
